The number of confirmed coronavirus cases in Bowie County, Texas, increased by 46 from Thursday to Monday, reaching a total of 1,296.

The Bowie County Emergency Operations Center reported 892 recoveries and 71 deaths because of COVID-19.

Cass County, Texas, reported an increase of cases from 338 to 370, with 284 recoveries, 71 active cases and 15 deaths.

Elsewhere in Northeast Texas, Morris County's tally rose from 184 to 186, Titus County's from 1,451 to 1,459 and Red River County's from 160 to 162, according to the Texas Department of State Health Services.

In Southwest Arkansas, Miller County's case count rose from 774 to 795, with 736 recoveries, 10 deaths and 49 active cases, according to the Arkansas Department of Health.

Lafayette County's case count increased from 98 to 109, Pike County's from 223 to 228, Nevada County's from 209 to 212, Little River County's from 338 to 342, Hempstead County's from 353 to 362, Howard County's from 455 to 460 and Sevier County's from 1,189 to 1,190, according to ADH.

Caddo Parish in Northwest Louisiana added 153 cases to reach 8,556, and Bossier Parish added 91 to reach 3,303, according to the Louisiana Department of Health.

Statewide, Arkansas reported 79,521 cumulative cases and 1,329 deaths, Louisiana reported 165,091 cases and 5,298 deaths and Texas reported 739,743 cases and 15,533 deaths.

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention reported 7,095,422 total cases so far in the U.S., with a national death toll of 204,328.
