The number of deaths because of COVID-19 in Miller County, Arkansas, increased by one from Friday to Tuesday, reaching a total of 10, according to the Arkansas Department of Health.

ADH reported 670 cumulative confirmed coronavirus cases in Miller County, an increase of 28 since Friday, with 594 patients recovered and 66 active cases being traced.

Elsewhere in Southwest Arkansas, Lafayette County's case count rose from 74 to 76, Pike County's from 182 to 189, Nevada County's from 165 to 166, Little River County's from 299 to 307, Hempstead County's from 335 to 337, Howard County's from 431 to 437 and Sevier County's from 1,164 to 1,173, according to ADH.

In Northeast Texas, Bowie County reported 1,040 cases, up from 1,005, with 559 recoveries, 71 deaths and 410 active cases, according to the local emergency Joint Operations Center.

Cass County's tally increased from 261 to 267, with 236 recoveries, 12 deaths and 19 active cases, according to the JOC.

Morris County's count increased from 159 to 162 and Titus County's from 1,381 to 1,387, according to the Texas Department of State Health Services. Red River County's count held at 151 cases.

Caddo Parish in Northwest Louisiana added 106 cases to reach 7,687, and Bossier Parish added 60 to reach 2,836, according to the Louisiana Department of Health.

Statewide, Arkansas reported 66,021 cumulative cases and 917 deaths, Louisiana reported 153,433 cases and 4,955 deaths, and Texas reported 641,791 cases and 13,553 deaths.

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention reported 6,287,362 total cases so far in the U.S., with a national death toll of 188,688.
