The number of confirmed coronavirus cases in Miller County, Arkansas, rose by 17 Wednesday to Thursday, reaching a total of 638.

Miller County has reported 578 recoveries, nine deaths and 51 active cases, according to the Arkansas Department of Health.

Lafayette County's count rose from 72 to 75, Pike County's from 177 to 179, Little River County's from 287 to 296, Hempstead County's from 330 to 335, Howard County's from 427 to 429 and Sevier County's from 1,160 to 1,163. Nevada County's count held at 162 cases.

Bowie County, Texas' case count increased by four Wednesday to Thursday, reaching a total of 1,004. The local emergency Joint Operations Center reported 502 recoveries in Bowie County, 71 deaths and 431 active cases being traced.

Cass County, Texas, reported 261 cases with 213 recoveries, 12 deaths and 36 active cases, according to the JOC.

Elsewhere in Northeast Texas, Red River's tally rose from 146 to 148, according to the Texas Department of State Health Services. Morris County's count held at 158 cases and Titus County's at 1,371.

Caddo Parish in Northwest Louisiana added 30 cases to reach 7,482, and Bossier Parish added four to reach 2,732, according to the Louisiana Department of Health.

Statewide, Arkansas reported 63,081 cumulative cases and 861 deaths, Louisiana reported 150,651 cases and 4,858 deaths, and Texas reported 625,347 cases and 13,091 deaths.

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention reported 6,087,403 total cases so far in the U.S., with a national death toll of 185,092.
