From Thursday to Monday, the number of confirmed coronavirus cases in Miller County, Arkansas, increased from 730 to 741, and Bowie County, Texas' case count rose from 1,139 to 1,176.

The Bowie County Emergency Operations Center reported 673 recoveries, 71 deaths and 432 active cases.

Miller County reported 688 recoveries, 10 deaths and 43 active cases, according to the Arkansas Department of Health.

Cass County, Texas, reported an increase of cases from 303 to 312, with 261 recoveries, 14 deaths and 37 active cases, according to the EOC.

Elsewhere in Northeast Texas, Morris County's tally rose from 175 to 182, Titus County's from 1,420 to 1,443 and Red River County's from 158 to 159, according to the Texas Department of State Health Services.

In Southwest Arkansas, Lafayette County's case count increased from 85 to 92, Pike County's from 213 to 219, Nevada County's from 186 to 205, Little River County's from 325 to 331, and Hempstead County's from 344 to 350, Howard County's from 447 to 450 and Sevier County's from 1,183 to 1,185, according to ADH.

Caddo Parish in Northwest Louisiana added 201 cases to reach 8,270, and Bossier Parish added 117 to reach 3,112, according to the Louisiana Department of Health.

Statewide, Arkansas reported 74,364 cumulative cases and 1,197 deaths, Louisiana reported 161,462 cases and 5,207 deaths, and Texas reported 698,387 cases and 14,917 deaths.
