

The number of confirmed coronavirus cases in Miller County, Arkansas, rose by one from Wednesday to Thursday, reaching a total of 674.

The Arkansas Department of Health also reported 613 recoveries in the county, 10 deaths and 51 active cases.

Elsewhere in Southwest Arkansas, Lafayette County's case count rose from 77 to 78, Pike County's from 191 to 204, Nevada County's from 170 to 171, Little River County's from 311 to 313, Howard County's from 437 to 439 and Sevier County's from 1,174 to 1,175, according to ADH. Hempstead County's tally held at 337 cases.

In Northeast Texas, Bowie County reported 1,059 cases, up from 1,046, with 643 recoveries, 71 deaths and 345 active cases, according to the local emergency Joint Operations Center.

Cass County's tally increased from 267 to 271, with 236 recoveries, 12 deaths and 23 active cases, according to the JOC.

Red River County's count held at 152 cases, Morris County's at 164 and Titus County's at 1,392, according to the Texas Department of State Health Services.

Caddo Parish in Northwest Louisiana added 33 cases to reach 7,762, and Bossier Parish added 12 to reach 2,861, according to the Louisiana Department of Health.

Statewide, Arkansas reported 66,804 cumulative cases and 940 deaths, Louisiana reported 155,419 cases and 4,991 deaths, and Texas reported 649,809 cases and 13,853 deaths.

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention reported 6,343,562 total cases so far in the U.S., with a national death toll of 190,262.
