The New Boston Independent School District announced Wednesday that a Crestview staff member was lab-confirmed to have COVID-19 during the evening of Tuesday, Aug. 25.

According to a notification letter from Superintendent Brian Bobbitt, the employee had not been on campus since Aug. 21, and did not have any symptoms until the morning of Aug. 25.

The letter was sent to parents, students and staff.

Due to privacy requirements, the district did not release the name or any further details about the infected individual.

The letter states:

"We are working closely with the local health department on this matter. Based on their close contact tracing, no other staff or students needed to be quarantined.

As always, we are doing everything we can to follow the protocols and guidelines we have in place. We ask you to remind your children of the importance of properly wearing their mask. I know many people have differing opinions about masks, but we have to follow the rules we have been given. Please let us know if you have any questions."
