

Two people died of COVID-19 over the weekend in Bowie County, Texas, bringing the county's total to 58.

COVID-19 deaths are recorded where patients die, not where they lived. Bowie County's number of confirmed coronavirus cases increased by 27, from 877 to 904, Friday to Monday, with 418 recoveries and 432 active cases are being traced in the county, according to the local emergency Joint Operations Center.

Cass County, Texas' count rose from 218 to 225, with 171 recoveries, nine deaths and 45 active cases, according to the JOC.

Elsewhere in Northeast Texas, Morris County's tally went up from 137 to 141, Red River County's from 140 to 143 and Titus County's from 1,285 to 1,293, according to the Texas Department of State Health Services.

In Southwest Arkansas, Miller County's case rose from 552 to 572, with 526 recoveries, five deaths and 40 active cases, according to the Arkansas Department of Health.

Nevada County's case count increases from 151 to 156, Pike County's from 154 to 157, Little River County's from 252 to 258, Hempstead County's from 294 to 307, Howard County's from 386 to 393 and Sevier County's from 1,109 to 1,121. Lafayette County's count held at 65.

Caddo Parish in Northwest Louisiana added 68 cases for a total of 7,180, and Bossier Parish added 37 cases to reach 2,557, according to the Louisiana Department of Health.

Statewide, Texas reported 580,384 cumulative cases and 11,395 deaths, Louisiana reported 143,566 cases with 4,623 deaths, and Arkansas reported 56,894 cases with 687 deaths.

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention reported 5,682,491 total cases so far in the U.S., with a national death toll of 176,223.
