

The number of deaths because of COVID-19 in Cass County, Texas, increased by one from Monday to Wednesday, reaching a total of 12.

The local emergency Joint Operations Center reported the death along with three new confirmed coronavirus cases, for a total of 260, 208 recovered patients and 40 active cases.

COVID-19 deaths are recorded where patients die, not where they lived. The JOC did not report coronavirus statistics Tuesday.

Bowie County, Texas' case count reached 1,000, up from 994, with 491 recoveries, 71 deaths and 438 active cases, according to the JOC.

Elsewhere in Northeast Texas, Red River's tally rose from 145 to 146 and Titus County's from 1,360 to 1,371, according to the Texas Department of State Health Services. Morris County's count held at 158 cases.

In Southwest Arkansas, Miller County's count increased from 612 to 621, with 574 recoveries, nine deaths and 38 active cases, according to the Arkansas Department of Health.

Lafayette County's count rose from 70 to 72, Little River County's from 284 to 287, Hempstead County's from 330 to 334, Howard County's from 425 to 427 and Sevier County's from 1,159 to 1,160. Nevada County's count held at 162 and Pike County's at 177.

Caddo Parish in Northwest Louisiana added 30 cases to reach 7,482, and Bossier Parish added four to reach 2,732, according to the Louisiana Department of Health.

Statewide, Arkansas reported 62,112 cumulative cases and 841 deaths, Louisiana reported 149,838 cases and 4,841 deaths, and Texas reported 621,667 cases and 12,870 deaths.

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention reported 6,047,692 total cases so far in the U.S., with a national death toll of 184,083.
