The number of deaths because of COVID-19 in Bowie County, Texas, increased by four from Monday to Tuesday.

The county death toll went up from 58 to 62, according to the local emergency Joint Operations Center. COVID-19 deaths are recorded where patients die, not where they lived.

The confirmed number of coronavirus cases in the county increased from 904 to 923, with 419 recoveries and 441 active cases being traced.

Cass County, Texas' case count rose from 225 to 227, with 178 recoveries, nine deaths and 40 active cases, according to the JOC.

Elsewhere in Northeast Texas, Morris County's tally increased from 141 to 142, Red River County's from 143 to 144 and Titus County's from 1,293 to 1,295, according to the Texas Department of State Health Services.

Officials in Caddo Parish, Louisiana, adjusted the parish's case count downward from 7,180 to 7,117, according to the Louisiana Department of Health. Bossier Parish added 62 cases to reach a total of 2,619.

Statewide, Texas reported 586,730 cumulative cases and 11,576 deaths, and Louisiana reported 144,116 cases with 4,656 deaths.

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention reported 5,715,567 total cases so far in the U.S., with a national death toll of 176,617.
