We also talked about the infrastructure bill that is going to be before the House before the end of September, Congressman Rutherford said that he is against it and that he's for infrastructure but not for other spending on social and environmental programs.

Summary: In this episode, Rich Jones talked with former Congressman Ander Crenshaw about what he remembered from 9/11 He says he was at a breakfast meeting when someone called him about the terror attacks. Like many other's he though initially it was just an accident, and then he realized it wasn't an accident. He says he was with his wife and getting information about the attacks. Crenshaw says 9/11 impacted Northeast Florida in a negative way initially since people we're not traveling. But the attacks did do a lot to bring more military resources to the area. Congressman John Rutherford says he remembers where he was on 9/11 as well. He says he was in Columbus and just wanted to talk to his wife after the attacks happened. He says in the years since when he was sheriff, he always would tell his officers that he didn't want to be the best first responder, but he wanted to make sure that a potential terror attack never happened in the first place. Senator Rick Scott says he just really respects and admires the first responders from that day.

Summary: In this episode, I talked with Hampton Ray with FDOT and he told me that plans to have toll lanes on I-95 from JTB to Atlantic Blvd and again from the Beltway down to International Golf Parkway have been scrapped and instead those lanes will just be general use lanes, or non-tolled lanes. He says the toll lanes that are under construction on the East Beltway should open sometime in November. He also says the tolling equipment in place before you get to JTB is flashing, but not taking any data as you drive underneath it. He also talked about some of the safety measures that are taken to make sure people stay safe for drivers and for workers. He says crews had, basically, a semi that was being used as a wall to block drivers from workers during recent emergency construction on the Buckman Bridge. He also encouraged people not to text and drive.
