- A) In the News: Possible effects of high pressure fracturing being legalized in the area, and the opportunities and challenges presented by "fracking", concealed carry law and proposed weapon ban in the state, proposed same-sex marriage legislation, continued coverage of the state pension reform saga.
- B) Weather: Stations provided broadcast of any severe weather bulletins and advisories, and ongoing coverage where necessary, pertaining to severe storms in the area as well as drought information.
- C) Health: Stations ran promos and made announcements heart disease and cancer awareness. During the hotter weather in late June, stations provided tips to our listeners on how to cope with and stay safe in the heat.
