Issues/Programs List for the period January 1 to March 31, 2024 for Station WMNT-CD programming treated the following issues of public concern:

1. ISSUE - Severe Winter Weather January 16th 2024

Inclement weather on Friday will be followed by a cold blast next week. An Arctic air mass is expected to arrive during the weekend, with single digit temperatures and an extended period of sub-zero wind chills from Saturday night through Jan. 17, according to the National Weather Service.

Also, a high wind warning is in effect until 7 p.m. Saturday for portions of northwest, north central, and northeast Ohio, it forecasted. Much of the area will see southwest winds of 25 to 35 mph with gusts up to 60 mph Saturday.

After a forecast high of 29 degrees and a low of 10 on Saturday, Toledo is expected to have highs of 11 degrees on Sunday and Monday, and 12 on Tuesday, not including the wind factor. The lows will drop to 3 degrees Sunday and 4 degrees Monday, according to the NWS, not including wind chill. Residents should dress warm accordingly and stay and keep children and elderly to limited exposure of the outside elements.

2. ISSUE - Norovirus Lucas County Health Report -Bulletin - February 1 2024

Health Department Reminds Residents to Take Precautions to Avoid Norovirus The Toledo-Lucas County Health Department is reminding the community that norovirus is common this time of year. Symptoms include vomiting, diarrhea, abdominal pain, headache, body aches, and sometimes a mild fever. People typically become ill 24 to 48 hours after exposure to the virus, and symptoms usually last one to two days. It is important to note that people can spread the virus for up to 2 weeks after their symptoms go away. Prevention Wash your hands after going to the bathroom • Wash your hands before handling food, beverages and ice • Wash your hands before eating. Stay home if you are ill. Keep sick infants and children out of areas where food is being handled and prepared.
