CBM Today

In 2014, doctors wrote more than 240 million prescriptions for opioids, enough for every American adult to have their own bottle of pills. As many as 1 in 4 people prescribed opioids for long-term pain struggles with addiction. People addicted to prescription opioids are 40 times more likely to be addicted to heroin. The opioid abuse costs America \$55 billion each year. The psa helps educate Americans about a safe way to manage pain through physical therapy.
