Program Descriptions

CBM Today

Local Pastors discuss a variety of issues facing our communities on a daily basis. Instruction is offered from a Biblical basis to address far reaching problems such as divorce, family finance, discipline of children, education, teen pregnancy, drug abuse, and how to pursue healthy lifestyles.

Crime, drug abuse, education, teen problems, and entertainment issues are covered regularly. Breaking news on issues that are thrust into prominence is an essential element of this excellent news program.

Nationally known speaker and author Joyce Meyer speaks daily to the needs associated with building strong relationships at home, at work, and through-out the community.
