

CHILDREN'S PROGRAMMING COMMERCIAL CERTIFICATION


July 1, 2015 through September 30, 2015

KMVT ("Station") certifies that any 12-and-under children's TV programs carried during this quarter on its primary and multicast channels were formatted to contain no more than the maximum amount of commercial time permitted under the Communications Act, as amended, 47 U.S.C. §73.670. Specifically,

(1) With respect to programs supplied by the CBS Television Network or the CW Television Network produced and broadcast for children 12 years of age and under, the station broadcast such programs as formatted and scheduled without adding any commercial time in excess of the statutory commercial limits, or otherwise scheduled such programs at a time and in a sequence so as to comply with the limits.

(2) With respect to 12-and-under children's TV programs supplied by syndicators or produced by the station, such programs were formatted and broadcast within the statutory commercial limits.

(3) Station has complied with the FCC's rules regarding the display of internet website addresses during 12-and-under children's programming.
