Red Cross volunteers respond to the homes, installing a smoke alarm on each floor for maximum safety of its residents. These alarms are fitted with special batteries that last for about ten years! Thereafter, a new alarm will need to be installed; thousands have been installed through “Operation Save A Life.”
