The experience of the love of God brought Thomas to found a healing ministry, Zenith Ministries, to serve men and women, ages 18-45, in a mission "to build community, help the hurting find healing, and accompany each other to living life to the full." God wants to heal those trapped in addiction and lead them to a beautiful life of freedom, which Thomas describes in his e-book, Seven Steps to Overcome Addiction.

Heather Triggs, a consecrated woman of the DeSales Secular Institute, gives testimony to the providential love and care of God the Father in her life, as she has come to discern, over a number of years, this vocation to "be the leaven in the world for Jesus."

Steeped in the wisdom and spirituality of St. Francis de Sales, these consecrated women share a rule of life and vows (poverty, chastity, obedience), and they live in the world. They live the consecrated life espoused to Christ Jesus, bringing His salvation and compassion into daily life.

They share the gift of St. John Paul II's *Theology of the Body*. Christopher West shares how the *Theology of the Body* radically changed his life in the early 1990s. The deepest hungers and desires of our hearts are placed in us by God to lead us to Him now and to an eternal wedding feast. Yes, Christopher tells us, "God wants to marry us." In this episode, we take a deep dive into questions such as: What does it mean to be human? Was the Incarnation God's "plan B?" How do I talk to and pray with my children and grandchildren in a way that upholds God's creating the human person male and female? What does it mean to have a body and that *the body is for the Lord*, as St. Paul exhorts? *Theology of the Body* is for everybody, a gift of the Fire of Divine Love.

Married for nearly 20 years and parents of three children ranging in age from 8 to 15, Becky and Chris Eldredge know the challenges facing families trying to find time to pray and discern God's will amid busy lives. In this episode, Becky, an Ignatian-trained

spiritual director and retreat leader, reflects on her own journey of faith, including how and when a "lived practice" of the Catholic faith became a reality for her.

Christopher and our co-hosts ponder how the teachings in this retreat inspire both love of God and the fulfillment of our deepest longings.

Clinical director of Holy Family Counseling Center, Peter Attridge, joins our co-hosts in an encouraging discussion about communicating, openly and fruitfully, in our families. As the father of three growing girls, Peter shares creative strategies for parenting that are informed, both by his clinical practice, and by personal challenges that we all face which are unique to our times. Peter is a licensed marriage and family therapist (LMFT) in the State of Georgia and supervises other professional helpers. This episode will inspire you to step back from your fears and communicate with those you love, especially children and young people, in an open and faith-filled way.
