**FCC RULE 47 CFR 73.3527 which describes the requirements for the Issues/Programs lists.**

***Issues/Programs lists.*** 47 CFR 73.3527 For nonexempt noncommercial educational broadcast [stations](#), every three months a list of programs that have provided the [station's](#) most significant treatment of community issues during the preceding three month period. The list for each calendar quarter is to be filed by the tenth day of the succeeding calendar quarter (e.g., January 10 for the quarter October-December, April 10 for the quarter January-March, etc.). The list shall include a brief narrative describing what issues were given significant treatment and the programming that provided this treatment. The description of the programs shall include, but shall [not](#) be limited to, the time, date, duration, and title of each program in which the issue was treated. The lists described in this paragraph shall be retained in the public inspection file until final action has been taken on the [station's](#) next license renewal application.
