All entries will line up at 5:30 p.m. in the parking lot south of City Hall on Main Street. The parade route will travel north on Main Street to Archer Park.

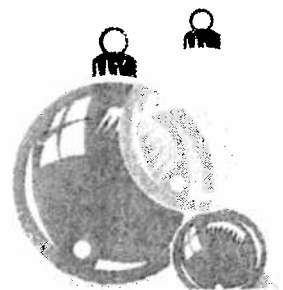


