IBRAM XOLANI KENDI IS AN ASSISTANT PROFESSOR OF AFRICAN AMERICAN HISTORY AT THE UNIVERSITY OF FLORIDA. HIS SECOND BOOK, STAMPED FROM THE BEGINNING: THE DEFINITIVE HISTORY OF RACIST IDEAS IN AMERICA, WAS RECENTLY AWARDED THE NATIONAL BOOK AWARD - NONFICTION. KENDI WAS BORN IN 1982 TO PARENTS WHO CAME OF AGE DURING THE BLACK POWER MOVEMENT IN NEW YORK CITY. THEY WERE STUDENT ACTIVISTS AND CHRISTIANS INSPIRED BY BLACK LIBERATION THEOLOGY. WHILE KENDI WAS IN HIGH SCHOOL, HIS FAMILY MOVED FROM JAMAICA, QUEENS, TO MANASSAS, VIRGINIA. HE TRAVELED FURTHER SOUTH AND ATTENDED FLORIDA A&M UNIVERSITY WHERE HE EARNED HIS UNDERGRADUATE DEGREES IN JOURNALISM AND AFRICAN AMERICAN STUDIES IN 2004. AFTER WORKING FOR A TIME AS A JOURNALIST, KENDI PURSUED HIS GRADUATE STUDIES. HE EARNED HIS DOCTORAL DEGREE IN AFRICAN AMERICAN STUDIES FROM TEMPLE UNIVERSITY IN 2010. KENDI HAS PUBLISHED FOURTEEN ESSAYS IN BOOKS AND ACADEMIC JOURNALS, INCLUDING THE JOURNAL OF AFRICAN AMERICAN HISTORY, JOURNAL OF SOCIAL HISTORY AND THE SIXTIES: A JOURNAL OF HISTORY, POLITICS AND CULTURE. KENDI IS THE AUTHOR OF THE AWARD-WINNING BOOK, THE BLACK CAMPUS MOVEMENT: BLACK STUDENTS AND THE RACIAL RECONSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION, 1965-1972.
