January, February, March 2018

- 1. March 15, 2018 – 10:30 AM– Issue: alcoholism and adultery and divorce - First Person with Wayne Shepherd. Dealing with alcohol and addiction. 28 minute duration.**

This week's interview features the story of Dan Page and his long-time addiction to drugs and an even longer addiction to alcohol. It started when he was 12 years old following the divorce of his parents. He became a Christian in 1982, but even after becoming a pastor he began drinking again. In 2005 he was admitted to a psychiatric hospital in NE Ohio where he spent a month of inpatient treatment for alcohol addiction. He's been clean since June 10th of that year and pastors the same church today. Dan offered his email address for anyone who would like to contact him regarding an addiction problem.

- 2. February 1, 2018 – 10:30 AM - First Person with Wayne Shepherd. Issue: Responding to God's call. 28 minute duration.**

Dr. James Hwang is an engineer by training, who once worked for NASA in developing robotics. Then, he was called of God to serve as a local church pastor.
