The show format includes a major investigative piece each week on topics ranging from immigration issues at home and abroad, government waste, national security concerns and vulnerabilities, whistleblower reports on government abuse and misdeeds. Full Measure is produced by and airs nationally on stations of the Sinclair Broadcast Group. This show airs Sunday 7:00am (Preempted for kids E/I on several occasions).

Q1-2024 QUARTERLY REPORT: Significant Local News Issues

There follows a listing of some of the significant issues responded to by this station, along with the most significant programming treatment of those issues for the period of January 1, 2023 – March 31, 2023. This list is by no means exhaustive. The order in which the issues appear does not reflect any priority or significance.

CRIME & JUSTICE

Great Day, Jan 25, 2023, 07:01 AM, 00:27, Local: A man was taken into custody after taking deputies on a chase through Central Fresno. Deputies said they tried to pull over a truck speeding near Abby and Blackstone around four this morning. The driver took off but stopped near Princeton and First after blowing out his tires. He tried to run, but deputies managed to detain him by using a stun gun.

Great Day, Jan 30, 2023, 08:01 AM, :20, Local: Police were on the hunt for a man accused of stabbing a woman. Investigators say this happened inside a home near Ferger and Thomas Avenues. Officers found the woman near Palm and Thomas Avenues and rushed her to the hospital.

Great Day, Feb 5, 2023, 08:09 AM, :23, Local: A man faced a felony assault charge after Visalia police say he tried to ram into a patrol car. It happened late Friday night on Central Avenue and Burke Street. Officers tried to pull over a driver in a silver Ford for an expired registration. He led them on a chase through downtown Visalia. Officers say he then tried to hit a patrol car head-on. The driver sped off again... But later surrendered.

Great Day, Feb 6, 2023, 08:01 AM, :19, Local: Clovis man was without a job after a thief stole his motor bike. It happened Sunday morning. He was out of a job and 25 hundred dollars. Police are searching through cameras.

Great Day, Jan 2, 2024, 07:03 AM, :35, Local: A Fresno family was searching for a new place to stay after an accused drunk driver plowed into their apartment the night before Christmas Eve. They say the driver narrowly missed their three-month-old daughter who was sleeping. The man who lives there says important documents, clothes and furniture were destroyed.

10 O'clock, Jan 8, 2024, 10:01PM, 03:30, Local: A family was murdered in their home over the weekend. This was a follow up on a murder as family and community members want answers. The story allowed for the family's voices to be heard and we were able to update them with what officers know so far.

10 O'clock, Jan 9, 2024, 10:01PM, 02:06, Local: Three people arrested for triple homicide in Reedley. This story was important as it provides an update to our viewers, and with such a major crime it allows us to update a community and put that at ease knowing the suspects are behind bars tonight.

10 O'clock, Jan 11, 2024, 10:01 PM, 02:00, Local: This was important to our viewers because a Fresno police officer was rushed to a hospital Thursday after he was exposed to an unknown substance while making an arrest in southeast Fresno. This was relevant to our market because the suspect who was arrested was a man in his mid-30's and had outstanding warrants. They also found a bag of substance in the backseat of the patrol car.

10 O'clock, Jan 12, 2024, 10:02 PM, 02:54, Local: This was important to our viewers because store thefts continue to grow. This was relevant to our market because the same accused thieves caught stealing from western wear stores across the central valley are targeting "Ariat" jackets and "rock revival" jeans.

10 O'clock, Jan 15, 2024, 10:02 PM, 02:35, Local: A man fighting for his life after hit by a motorcyclist. This story was important because it's a hit and run, and with our viewers help, officers could catch the suspect who did it, if they recognize him the footage that we air. This was relevant to our viewers because officers need the public's assistance, and it happened in the area.

10 O'clock, Jan 16, 2024, 10:02 PM, 02:24, Local: A store charging a recycling fee on some containers following new California laws. This was important to our viewers because it affects them and their finances when they are shopping. It was relevant because it's happening at local stores and a viewer reached out and wanted answers.

10 O'clock, Jan 17, 2024, 10:03 PM, 01:52, Local: This was important to our viewers because a dog was shot in Fresno and police are trying to find the suspect. This was relevant to our market because Fresno police are encouraging anyone with information to contact the department if they know or have seen the suspect responsible for shooting the husky who made a miraculous recovery.

10 O'clock, Jan 18, 2024, 10:04 PM, 02:25, Local: This was important to our viewers because a husky who was shot in Fresno and never identified was given to a local animal shelter, where they started a naming contest for the dogs' new name. This was relevant to our market because this was a story that viewers have been keeping up with, and Fresno police continue to ask people to be on the lookout if they think they've seen the suspect responsible for the shooting.

Great Day, Jan 23, 2024, 05:03 AM, 00:47, Local: Mail thieves in North Fresno are targeting an apartment complex near River Park shopping center. Video shows a woman prying open a community mailbox, then shoving the mail into a bag held by a man. The property supervisor adds that thieves broke into at least half a dozen cars and stole one car.

10 O'clock, Jan 23, 2024, 10:03 PM, 02:32, Local: This was important to our viewers because there has been a rise in property thefts in many communities. This was relevant to our market because there will be many viewers, some who have had their own properties stolen, that will understand the frustration of getting piece of property stolen. Thankfully the motorcycle thief was found, and the motorcycle was returned to the owner.

10 O'clock, Jan 23, 2024, 10:01PM, 00:37, Local: A search warrant was served in the ongoing investigation for the homicide in Reedley. This story was an update to our previous coverage, as a whole community was mourning the loss of a family who was murdered. This was relevant because of the impact the story has on community and people want answers as to what happened.

Great Day, Jan 24, 2024, 05:03 AM, 00:58, Local: Fresno County prosecutors were working to undo parts of Prop 47. The prop first passed back in 2014. It reclassified felonies to misdemeanors for retail theft under \$950. The new initiative would allow prosecutors to charge repeat offenders with a felony instead of a misdemeanor. This was important as retail crime has become so bad in the state that the governor organized a retail crime taskforce.

10 O'clock, Jan 25, 2024, 10:02 PM, 03:06, Local: This was important to our viewers because the home security camera Ring announces it will no longer allow police to request video directly from the user on the app. This was relevant to our market because law enforcement agencies can still access videos through ring using a search warrant without user consent in limited circumstances. agencies believe this could be due to privacy concerns.

10 O'clock, Jan 26, 2024, 10:04 PM, 02:13, Local: This was important to our viewers because Fresno County supervisors say, illegal dumping has become an eyesore have only gotten worse in recent years. This was relevant to our market because viewers could report illegal dumpsites by using Fresno County connect mobile app or by calling public works so they can clean it up.

10 O'clock, Jan 27, 2024, 10:03pm, 02:19, Local: This was important to our viewers because many people in Fresno experience break ins and ask the community for help. This was relevant to our market because theft and burglaries are prevalent in the Central Valley, from homes to businesses. There are cases reported weekly.

10 O'clock, Jan 31, 2024, 10:05 PM, 03:30, Local: This was important to our viewers because one small Fresno business owner says she was being the voice for multiple business owners in one northeast shopping center. This was relevant to our market because the owner says she's had enough after thieves stole roughly around 35-hundred dollars' worth of merchandise early Thursday morning. that's not including the cost of replacing the window her insurance doesn't cover. this a problem many business owners around the state have been struggling with.

10 O'clock, Feb 6, 2024, 10:07 PM, 03:09, Local: Governor Gavin Newsom sending 120 CHP officers to Oakland. This was important because the city was seeing a rise in crime, so much so that businesses are shutting down for good. This was relevant to our viewers as many of them travel to the Bay area or have family in the area that was affected by that crime. Often Fresno CHP catches some of those criminals on Interstate 5 too, so even though Oakland isn't necessarily close it still plays a role for our viewers.

10 O'clock, Feb 7, 2024, 10:05 PM, 01:37, Local: This was important to our viewers because three men were arrested following a chase with Fresno police. This was relevant to our market because Police say the three men ditched a car and ran onto the highway to escape officers. Shortly after two of them ended up being held at gunpoint by a homeowner. Neighbors got involved, making it possible for officers to find the suspects.

10 O'clock, Feb 9, 2024, 10:04 PM, 02:41, Local: A beekeeper visiting the area had more than 108 hives stolen. This was important because we are seeing an increase in thefts and viewers can help keep an eye out on the stolen hives.

Great Day, Feb 13, 2024, 08:02 AM, 00:20, Local: An 18-year-old was facing arson charges, accused of starting a string of dumpster fires in downtown Fresno. Fresno fire investigators say surveillance video helped them identify 'Alfred Sosa'. We're told he intentionally lit a dumpster on fire and then pushed it up against a building. The fires damaged several buildings, including 'peerless' and 'valley foods'.

10 O'clock, Feb 15, 2024, 10:13 PM, 02:59, Local: A person has died following a shooting at the Kansas City Chiefs Parade. This was follow-up to our coverage as tonight we have an update tonight and what led to the shooting. This was relevant because it happened following the Super Bowl win, so people wanted to know what caused the shooting and if it was over the winning team itself.

Great Day, Feb 20, 2024, 08:04 AM, 00:19, Local: A teenager and man are on the mend this morning after a shooting in Tulare. Police say they found a 15-year-old and a 23-year-old who were shot near west Meadows Avenue and South Vetter Street around six last night. Both were taken to a hospital. Their conditions are not known this morning.

Great Day, Feb 22, 2024, 05:02 AM, 01:10, Local: The search was on for whoever tried to kidnap a 9-year-old girl in Sanger. She screamed and yelled, which was what investigators say saved her life. The city's police chief says it's best to talk to your children about what to do in situations like this. This was important as more than 300,000 children were reported missing in the U.S. over the last two years.

Great Day, Feb 28, 2024, 07:06 AM, :50, Local: A man was under arrest, accused of smashing cars with a meat cleaver and attacking officers in West Fresno. It happened in a neighborhood near Carol and Prospect. A Doordash driver was the one who called police after he says the man attacked his car. The man was believed to be high on meth.

Great Day, Feb 29, 2024, 07:01 AM, :55, Local: The search was on for a person who vandalized two cars in Northwest Fresno. The vandal was seen keying a blue car around 3:45 Tuesday morning. That person then slashed a truck tire and returned to key the blue car again. The father says it seems this was targeted - and voiced his disappointment.

Great Day, Feb 29, 2024, 08:01 AM, :17, Local: Fresno police say these accused thieves stole bank cards from a car parked near Blackstone and Sierra Avenues. shortly after the burglary, the thieves were caught on camera using stolen cards.

Great Day, Mar 5, 2024, 08:04 AM, :24, Local: Fresno County sheriff's deputies needed the community's help to find whoever was responsible for a deadly shooting in Sanger. This 43-year-old was shot outside his home around 5:30 Saturday morning. It happened off South Indianola Avenue. Deputies are working to collect surveillance video and talking with people who knew him. Investigators say they believe this shooting was not random.

10 O'clock, Mar 8, 2024, 10:01PM, 03:49, Local: A central valley woman was killed in a DUI crash in another state. This was important because the driver of the crash was still on the loose and has not paid for his crime. This was relevant because of the local tie to the valley.

Great Day, Mar 26, 2024, 07:05 AM, 01:07, Local: Fresno police are still searching for three people accused of shooting and killing 21-year-old Adriana Gonzales back in November. She was fighting with someone in another car when she was shot. Detectives identified three people who they say are on the run.

Great Day, Mar 27, 2024, 05:04 AM, 00:26, Local: Fresno police are turning to the community for help finding an accused killer. 36-year-old Angel Gaytan was identified as the man who killed 37-year-old Dominic Greco last month. Detectives believe Gaytan was homeless and hangs out near McKinley and Chestnut. Anyone with information was asked to call Crime Stoppers.

Great Day, Feb 21, 2024, 07:02 AM, 01:29, Local: A Kingsburg family was out \$300 after scammers swindled them with fake money when buying a Nintendo Switch. The man who made the exchange says the interaction lasted less than a minute, and the scammer took off in a red sedan. He was urging others not to sell things at night, since it could be difficult to capture on surveillance video.

10 O'clock, Mar 19, 2024, 10:03PM, 03:00, Local: The Clovis Police Department was a part of a state-wide grant to crack down on retail thefts. This was a follow up from when the money was announced and to see how Clovis Police have been doing since they received the grant. This was relevant to our viewers because it looks at what officers are doing with the grant they received as they try to make the community safer, especially against thefts.

Great Day, Jan 19, 2024, 05:02 AM, 00:42, Local: A police officer was recovering, and a man was hurt after an officer-involved shooting in Dinuba. Officers received reports of a disturbance at a home near Dinuba High School around eight last night. Police tried to negotiate with him, but he shot an officer, forcing police to shoot him. The officer was expected to recover, but the condition of the man who was shot was unknown.

Great Day, Feb 26, 2024, 07:02 AM, 01:02, Local: A Fresno band was looking for whoever stole equipment from their truck after a weekend show. The guitarist and vocalist say he left the equipment in his truck around 12:30 Sunday morning. The next morning, it was gone. This was a reminder to viewers to always keep an eye on your belongings.

Great Day, Mar 15, 2024, 07:02 AM, :56, Local: Police looked for a shooter who sent three men to a hospital in Central Fresno last night. ShotSpotter technology alerted officers to a shooting at an apartment complex near Dakota and Hughes around 9:30 last night. Officers say one of the men managed to drive himself to a hospital; the other two went by ambulance. Anyone with information was asked to please call Crime Stoppers.

Great Day, Mar 20, 2024, 07:03 AM, :45, Local: A Fresno homeowner was turning to the community for help finding his stolen Ram truck. The thieves took advantage of keyless entry technology to get inside and take off. Police are encouraging people with this model of truck to install a lock on the data port, which can prevent thieves from reprogramming the keys. This was important because the CHP reports that almost half of all car thefts in 2022 were trucks.

ECONOMY

Great Day, Jan 1, 2024, 07:05 AM, :46, Local: A lot of new laws are going into effect in California in 2024. Minimum wage was going up for fast food employees in April, and health care professionals in June. This was important to viewers, as the law was already affecting delivery drivers who were laid off from Pizza Hut.

10 O'clock, Jan 6, 2024, 10:02 PM, 02:25, Local: This was important to our viewers because of the transparency and accountability in the allocation of taxpayer funds for large-scale infrastructure projects. This was relevant to our market because the California High-Speed Bullet Train, originally envisioned to connect Northern and Southern California, was intended to stimulate economic activity. The central purpose of the high-speed train projects was to enhance connectivity between regions.

Great Day, Jan 10, 2024, 07:04 AM, 00:48, Local: Governor Newsom was presenting the state's 2024-25 budget today. This comes as California faces a record \$68b deficit - the highest in state history. There are about \$24B in savings. Republicans are calling for cuts to Medi-Cal expansion for undocumented migrants - but the governor says he was sticking to a plan to cut programs that haven't started.

10 O'clock, Feb 2, 2024, 10:02 PM, 02:11, Local: This was important to our viewers because Venezuelan asylum seekers arrived in Fresno, prompting a meeting after the asylum seekers were brought to the city. This was relevant to our market because the county of Fresno was going to be the lead on helping the asylum seekers. Social services were to meet with families to determine what happens next.

10 O'clock, Feb 8, 2024, 10:05 PM, 03:03, Local: Fresno's Chestnut Pediatrics started charging a monthly fee just to keep the business up and running. This was important to our viewers because they are the ones who would be paying the monthly fee. This was relevant because as minimum wage keeps going up, more companies are coming forward with price increases.

10 O'clock, Feb 27, 2024, 10:23 PM, 03:00, Local: Macy's was downsizing and closing 150 underperformed stores including the one in San Francisco Union Square. This was important because that store was a staple to that area and even where they put up the Macy's Great Christmas Tree. It was relevant to the area because many viewers have shopped at that store and have memories of that area.

10 O'clock, Mar 11, 2024, 10:01PM, 02:18, Local: PG&E was planning to raise their prices once again. This was important because it's the major utility company in the central valley. This was relevant because our viewers needed to know why their utility bill was going up.

10 O'clock, Mar 12, 2024, 10:07PM, 00:25, Local: PG&E explains why they are raising their prices. This was a follow up story to a package we did the night before that the company has responded back. It's relevant because viewers are going to want to know where their money was going.

Great Day, Mar 21, 2024, 07:05 AM, 00:39, Local: The city's solid waste services proposed its first-rate hike in 15 years. The public utilities assistant director declared the division "functionally bankrupt". Annual operation costs went up \$7.5 million in the previous decade. Truck maintenance was almost three million dollars. This was important to viewers, as they have a chance to make their voices heard before prices potentially go up.

Great Day, Jan 12, 2024, 07:06 AM, 00:29, Local: Faculty throughout the CSU system were preparing to go on strike. It was expected to start on January 22nd - which was when most universities in the system return to class, though Fresno State returns next week. The CA Faculty Association was asking for a 12% raise and other benefits. Educators are expected to notify students if classes are cancelled. This was important for viewers as it could affect the start of the spring semester.

EDUCATION

10 O'clock, Jan 22, 2024, 10:01PM, 00:37, Local: The California Faculty Association and the California State University Faculty was over. This was important as Fresno was home to CSU, so this was a major story we have continued to cover as it affected both students and faculty from across the valley.

10 O'clock, Jan 31, 2024, 10:01 PM, 03:05, Local: This was important to our viewers because the California faculty association went on strike and some students feel like it'll have consequences on their education. This was relevant to our market because some professors at Fresno state expected this to happen and added it in their syllabus. Some said "because of extenuating circumstances" a possible work stoppage might happen during the spring semester...some teachers also added quote "our working conditions are student learning conditions. we seek to protect both."

Great Day, Feb 14, 2024, 07:03 AM, 01:12, Local: Fresno Unified was apologizing after leaving a teacher who uses a wheelchair out of a field trip. The superintendent says the teacher put in a request for accommodation ahead of time but was not in place on the day of the trip.

ENVIRONMENT

10 O'clock, Jan 3, 2024, 10:01 PM, 02:47, Local: The first sight of snow hit the Central Valley and most of California. This was important to our viewers because they could head to the mountains and see snow and make the right preparations before going.

10 O'clock, Jan 5, 2024, 10:07 PM, 00:49, Local: A woman dies after getting hit by a wave at Pismo Beach. This was important to our viewers because the coast was in its high tide season and the accident shows how dangerous the waves can be. It's a safety reminder to a tragedy, especially since a lot of families are still on vacation following the new year, they want to head to the coast for family vacations. The story even shares what they could expect to see next week if they head on over to the coast.

10 O'clock, Jan 13, 2024, 10:06 PM, 02:20, Local: This was important to our viewers because after last year's wetter than normal weather year -- meteorologist's worry this year might bring us back into the drought. This was relevant to our market because meteorologists are hoping the weather could change in our favor.

Great Day, Jan 15, 2024, 05:12 AM, 00:56, Local: Meteorologists with the NWS are voicing concerns that low snowpack could send the state back into a drought. The Sierra snowpack was at measured at 40% of what was considered normal. At the same time last year, it was at 200%. Meteorologists say avoiding a drought could depend on whether we get more atmospheric rivers. This was important knowledge for farmers who depend on water in the state's reservoirs.

Great Day, Jan 18, 2024, 06:38 AM, 00:40, Local: Peak reservation system opened for Yosemite national park. Reservations are required between April and October. It's intended to manage crowds. Also meant to prevent long lines of cars. Reservations can be accessed online and over the phone.

Great Day, Jan 18, 2024, 07:06 AM, 00:55, Local: The CEO of the Fresno Mission spent 24 hours on a bench to highlight homelessness. He was using the opportunity to have conversations with people about homelessness and show the conditions the homeless endure in winter. This was important because a recent report shows Fresno was among the top 10 cities for homelessness.

10 O'clock, Jan 29, 2024, 10:03 PM, 02:23, Local: Water was released as major reservoirs hit their capacity. This was important as California was under drought warning for several years and with the latest storm ending the drought, community members as well as farmers want to make sure that water was getting its fair use.

10 O'clock, Feb 1, 2024, 10:02 PM, 01:36, Local: An atmospheric river made its way through the central valley. This was important to our viewers because several areas saw hail that looked like snow covering the ground. and it's important to remind viewers so they know whether to stay inside or to go out and plan things. It's relevant to their safety and weather was a big thing around the valley since most time all we see was sunny days.

10 O'clock, Feb 3, 2024, 10:03 PM, 01:23, Local: This was important to our viewers because an evacuation warning has been issued for people at risk for mudslides and the national weather service says the storm might cause other problems too. This was relevant to our market because it gives viewers current information and tips on what they need to do to avoid getting caught in possible floods and power outages.

10 O'clock, Feb 4, 2024, 10:03 PM, 01:46, Local: This was important to our viewers because across the valley and the central coast there has seen flooding, dangerous winds trees falling and other extreme weather. This was relevant to our market because it gives locals and travelers information on what they need to do, to make sure they stay safe, when moving through areas impacted by the storm.

10 O'clock, Feb 13, 2024, 10:04 PM, 00:22, Local: The Ocean Dunes camping closed for a week because of high tide. This was important as reservations were cancelled, and plans needed to be changed. This was relevant to our viewers as it was a three-day weekend, and families tend to go to the beach as it's a close family get away.

10 O'clock, Feb 19, 2024, 10:01 PM, 02:27, Local: A winter storm has taken over the central valley with down trees, powerlines, and washed-out roads. This was important to our viewers as this impacted some of their commutes and neighborhoods. This was relevant because Californians get crazy over weather and it's important to remind people of what happens in their area but also to remain safe.

Great Day, Feb 20, 2024, 05:07 AM, 00:41, Local: A homeless encampment near a Central Fresno neighborhood was to be removed. Trash had been piling up at a canal bank overseen by the Fresno Irrigation District for months - and neighbors had been complaining. The irrigation district's general manager says the encampment was to be cleaned up within the next week.

10 O'clock, Feb 20, 2024, 10:06 PM, 02:08, Local: Fresno City was working to crackdown on graffiti, by removing it and creating a task force to track down taggers. This was important because it shows viewers what Fresno was doing to help clean up our neighborhoods and catch suspects. This was relevant because city and community members have been working to clear up crime and beautify Fresno.

Great Day, Mar 22, 2024, 07:07 AM, 00:29, Local: Fresno's flood control district was introducing "No Spray Days". It's meant to control pesticides. If the forecast calls for rain, pesticides can't be sprayed within that 24-hour period. This was important for viewers to know because pesticides and other harmful chemicals could be carried through runoff and affect our groundwater.

10 O'clock, Jan 7, 2024, 10:08 PM, 01:57, Local: This was important to our viewers because the beloved Fresno Playland was closing after almost 70 years in business. This was relevant to our market because the park was a Valley favorite and many locals felt it was their obligation to push for their park to stay open.
