Devine Intervention – Monday-Friday

Devine Intervention -- 0600-0900

01-06-17: Mike Sexton, Tim Kraayenbrink, Neven Mulholland

Topics included upcoming legislation regarding handguns for minors, fireworks, and other topics that will effect Iowa in the upcoming session of the Legislature. They also talked about the recent election where Democrats were defeated and a Rebpulican majority will be in power this year.

Devine Intervention – 0600-0900

01-04-17: Jim Stubbs and Keith Dencklau

Topics included drunk driving arrests in the county related to holidays, body cameras for the Sherriff's Department, increased fatalities for the state in 2016, and others. Sheriff Stubbs explained the body cameras for the department and touched on distracted driving.

12-28-16: Terry Moehnke

Topics included crime locally and nation wide, Oleson Park Zoo plans, the upcoming construction season, bids to remove the hydro electric damn, the new community garden in the hydro electric park, and others. They touched on the process of starting the zoo and removing the dam, the Decker addition, new apartments on 7th St behind Dairy Queen, and the neighbors initially being opposed to the new apartments.

11-01-16: Neven Conrad

Topics included rezoning at the mall and opposition to it, purchase of the right-of-way, possible financing, and Pat Greve, who was a fire fighter fired for OWI. He appealed his termination and was reinstated to the Fort Dodge Fire Department. They discussed the hearing regarding the termination and the particulars including the different types of licenses.
