Dear Mr. Franklin:

This letter is to serve notice to you that KLiP Interactive has begun the process of deactivating our cable systems in Flint River, Climax, Irwinton (all in Georgia) and St. Regis and Darby (both in Montana). We have concluded that generally applicable market conditions and competitive factors such as the Dish have made it extremely difficult for us to effectively compete and be financially successful in these systems

As of January 25, 2008, we have 120 subscribers combined in all five (5) of these systems. It is our anticipation that we will deactivate these five headends on **February 29, 2008**. Note that of the systems being shut down, we only carry WTVL in our Flint River and Climax systems. Note that we only carry WTWC in our Climax system.
