RE: WTWC Request for Syndicated Exclusivity

Dear Mr. Butler:

WTWC-TV's request for syndicated exclusivity for "Judge Joe Brown," "The Insider," "Entertainment Tonight," "Rachael Ray," and "Swift Justice With Nancy Grace" within the zone within which WTWC-TV is entitled to enforce protection on the Charter Communications' ("Charter") systems serving lineups located within the Tallahassee-Thomasville DMA has been forwarded to my attention.

WTWC-TV's request was reviewed according to the rules of the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC").

The FCC rules regarding a television station's request for syndicated exclusivity provide for a significantly viewed exception.

47 C.F.R. 76.106(a) of the FCC rules reads in full,

"Notwithstanding the requirements of §§76.101 through 76.105, a broadcast signal is not required to be deleted from a cable community unit when that cable community unit falls, in whole or in part, with that signal's grade B contour, or when the signal is significantly viewed pursuant to §76.54 in the cable community."

Upon review, Charter finds there is a significantly viewed alternative station, WALB, carried on Charter's Lake Park, Georgia lineup airing episodes of "Rachael Ray" and "Entertainment Tonight."

Pursuant to §76.106(a) of the FCC rules, Charter denies WTWC-TV's request for syndicated exclusivity for "Rachael Ray" and "Entertainment Tonight" on the Lake Park, Georgia lineup.


Also upon review, Charter did not find another over-the-air broadcaster airing episodes of "Judge Joe Brown," "The Insider," or "Swift Justice With Nancy Grace" within the zone within which WTWC-TV is entitled to enforce protection. Syndicated exclusivity does not need to be provided.
