

Broadcast syndication exclusivity (aka syndex) protects your station's rights to syndicated television programs by granting exclusive rights to your station for that program in your Nielsen DMA. Upon request from your station, cable system headends in your DMA must block airings of programs you own when they air on broadcast stations from outside your DMA. Syndex applies only to other broadcast stations, not to cable channels.

A hypothetical example...

KMYS San Antonio airs "Two and a Half Men". The Time Warner cable system headend in the city of New Braunfels in the northern part of the San Antonio DMA carries broadcast stations from San Antonio and from the Austin DMA. When KNVA Austin airs "Two and a Half Men", this cable system headend must block that airing.

The starting point in the syndex process is handled through special reports your station should order from Nielsen. Please review with your general manager before placing the order.

* The station carriage report. \$1,000 per station. This report lists all cable system headends that carry your station, and also provides other key information including your cable channel position and number of subscribers. This report must be ordered to enable you to order the next two reports.

** The non-carriage report. \$250 per station. While this report is not necessary in the syndex process, it lists all cable system headends in your DMA that do not carry your station, and contact information for those head ends. This is valuable information in your attempts to get carriage on these systems.

*** The channel line-up report. \$525 per station. This report lists the complete channel line-up for all cable system headends that carry your station, including contact name, address, and telephone number. This is valuable information in the syndex process, as well as in network duplication issues, and in the retransmission consent process.

Syndex applies only to certain syndicated programs. I'll request syndex riders for the programs in the list at the bottom of this note. When I receive the riders from the syndication companies, I'll get them to you.

Review the Nielsen station carriage report to identify those cable system headends with 1,000 or more subscribers. Syndex protection is applicable only on those cable system headends with 1,000 or more subscribers.

Review the Nielsen channel line-up report to identify cable system headends that carry broadcast stations from outside your DMA.

Complete a syndex request letter (form letter attached) for each program listed below that you own for each cable system headend which has 1,000 or more subscribers and carries broadcast stations from outside your DMA. Another option is to complete a letter for all cable system headends with 1,000 or more subscribers regardless of their current channel line-up.

Attach the syndex rider you'll receive from me to the letter. Mail both to the applicable cable system headend using United States Postal Service certified mail, return receipt requested.

Please note cable systems have 60 days to implement syndex blocking. It is best to request syndex protection as far in advance as possible.

If a cable system headend asks you for a copy of the actual program contract, please contact me.
