Community Clipboard Announcement: These announcements are made throughout the day, and are made up of organizations churches and other groups sending in information about activities going on in their local communities. Topics and organizations vary. Copies of

announcements are in the public file, and come from the information sent to us.

Daughters of Promise: Hosted by Christine Wyrtzen, this two minute featurette is heard weekdays. The program deals with a wide variety of issues and gives us words of encouragement. The program occasionally contains music performed by Christine Wyrtzen.
