Re: Retransmission Consent Election

Dear Mr. Pietila:

We are in receipt of the Winnebago Cooperative Telecom Association (“WCTA”) letter, dated June 29, 2017, stating its intent to initiate a video service in Bancroft and Lakota, Kossuth County, Iowa, which is in the Des Moines-Ames, IA Designated Market Area (“DMA”). Nexstar Broadcasting, Inc. (“Nexstar”) is the licensee of television broadcast station WOI-DT, Ames, Iowa, which is assigned to the Des Moines-Ames, IA DMA.

Please be advised that Nexstar hereby invokes its rights pursuant to Section 325(b) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, and Section 76.64(a) of the FCC’s rules, to bar retransmission of the station’s signal by WCTA on its referenced systems except pursuant to our express written authority granted pursuant to a retransmission consent agreement between you and us. This election is a continuing election from the date hereof through the initiation and continuing provision of service by your systems. In addition, this election is made for each and every community or video service that WCTA intends to serve in the Des Moines-Ames, IA DMA.

We look forward to negotiating a retransmission consent agreement with you for WCTA’s retransmission of WOI-DT on its new system. Please contact the undersigned at eryder@nexstar.tv when you are ready to commence retransmission negotiations.
