4:30A - 1/26

A WARNING FOR PARENTS IN SPOTSYLVANIA COUNTY.. THE SHERIFF'S OFFICE IS INVESTIGATING A REPORT OF SUSPICIOUS ACTIVITY NEAR FREEDOM MIDDLE SCHOOL. OFFICIALS SAY A MAN APPEARED TO FOLLOW CHILDREN FROM THE SCHOOL TO A NEARBY HOUSE. THE MAN IS DESCRIBED AS WHITE.. 30 TO 40-YEARS-OLD.. SIX FEET TALL.. AND ABOUT 190 POUNDS. HE HAS CURLY GRAY HAIR WITH A BALD SPOT.. AND A CLOSE CUT GRAY BEARD.

5AM - 3/8

MARYLAND LAWMAKERS WANT TO MAKE IT EASIER TO REMOVE ELECTED OFFICIALS CONVICTED OF A CRIME. THIS COMES AFTER FORMER PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY COUNCILWOMAN LESLIE JOHNSON USED A LOOPHOLE IN THE LAW TO STAY IN OFFICE AFTER PLEADING GUILTY TO CONSPIRACY CHARGES LAST YEAR. THE HOUSE AND SENATE ARE CONSIDERING BILLS REQUIRING STATE AND COUNTY OFFICIALS FOUND GUILTY OF A FELONY TO RESIGN IMMEDIATELY.

6AM - 2/23

TURNING TO THE NORTHWEST CRIME WAVE... THERE WERE SEVERAL MORE ROBBERIES REPORTED IN THE DISTRICT LAST NIGHT AND EARLY THIS MORNING. POLICE SAY THERE HAVE BEEN MORE THAN 625-ROBBERIES ACROSS THE CITY SINCE THE BEGINNING OF THE YEAR. MANY OF THOSE CRIMES HAVE INVOLVED GUNS. D-C POLICE WILL ADDRESS RESIDENTS CONCERNS DURING A COMMUNITY MEETING AT ALICE DEAL MIDDLE SCHOOL IN NORTHWEST TONIGHT.

6AM - 3/28

TWO SUSPECTS ARE UNDER ARREST AFTER A DOUBLE SHOOTING IN LANGLEY PARK. TWO MEN BELIEVED TO BE HOMELESS WERE SHOT YESTERDAY DURING A ROBBERY ATTEMPT.. ON RIGGS ROAD. THEY SUFFERED SERIOUS BUT NON-LIFE-THREATENING INJURIES. POLICE FOUND THE SUSPECTS' CAR A MILE-AND-A-HALF AWAY. POLICE ARRESTED THE TWO MEN.. AND FOUND A TODDLER IN THE BACK SEAT OF THE SUSPECTS' CAR. THE CHILD WAS NOT HURT.. AND IS NOW BACK WITH HIS OR HER MOTHER.

6PM - 1/19

A NEW REPORT SAYS MILITARY SUICIDES ARE LEVELING OFF. 278 ACTIVE DUTY, GUARD, AND RESERVE SOLDIERS COMMITTED SUICIDE IN 20-11, COMPARED TO 304 THE YEAR BEFORE. THE ARMY ALSO SAYS THERE'S BEEN A BIG JUMP IN OTHER CRIMINAL BEHAVIOR. SEX CRIMES AND DOMESTIC VIOLENCE HAVE JUMPED THIRTY PERCENT SINCE 2006. CHILD ABUSE IS UP BY FORTY-THREE PERCENT.

4:30AM - 1/17

THERE WILL SOON BE A VACANCY ON THE ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY COUNCIL. TONIGHT.. THE COUNCIL WILL MEET TO DISCUSS FILLING DARYL JONES' SEAT. JONES.. A DEMOCRAT FROM SEVERN.. IS SET TO REPORT TO PRISON ON MONDAY. HE WAS CONVICTED OF FAILING TO FILE FIVE YEARS' WORTH OF FEDERAL TAX RETURNS. THAT'S A MISDEMEANOR.

THEY'RE KICK-STARTING AN EFFORT TO USE STATE POLITICIANS AS LEVERAGE IN THEIR PITCH FOR FULL VOTING RIGHTS IN CONGRESS. COUNCIL MEMBERS MICHAEL BROWN AND DAVID CATANIA PLAN TO TESTIFY BEFORE NEW HAMPSHIRE STATE LAWMAKERS.

A SALES TAX INCREASE OR GAS TAX INCREASE ARE BEING TOSSED AROUND. SCHOOL AND SHERIFF'S OFFICIALS ARE INVESTIGATING A REPORT THAT SOME LOUDOUN COUNTY STUDENTS TOOK MARIJUANA-LACED BROWNIES TO SCHOOL. THE ALLEGED INCIDENT HAPPENED YESTERDAY.. AT FARMWELL STATION MIDDLE SCHOOL IN ASHBURN. THE LOUDOUN COUNTY SHERIFF SAYS IT APPEARS.. JUST A FEW STUDENTS WERE INVOLVED. IT'S UNCLEAR IF CHARGES WILL BE FILED.

A BILL REQUIRING DRUG SCREENING OF WELFARE RECIPIENTS.. NOW GOES TO VIRGINIA'S HOUSE OF DELEGATES. THE STATE SENATE PASSED THE BILL YESTERDAY. THE MEASURE WOULD REQUIRE AN INITIAL DRUG SCREENING OF APPLICANTS. IT WOULD BE FOLLOWED BY DRUG TESTING, IF OFFICIALS SUSPECTED ILLEGAL DRUG USE. ANYONE TESTING POSITIVE COULD LOSE BENEFITS FOR A YEAR

11PM - 1/17

THE DEBATE OVER MEDICAL MARIJUANA INTENSIFIES IN THE DISTRICT TONIGHT-- AS THE D-C COUNCIL PASSES EMERGENCY LEGISLATION AIMED AT ALIEVATING CONCERNS. DISTRICT LEADERS MET WITH RESIDENTS OVER THE ISSUE IN THE CITY'S FIFTH WARD TONIGHT. HOURS EARLIER, THE D-C COUNCIL PASSED A BILL THAT WILL RESTRICT THE NUMBER OF MEDICAL MARIJUANA CULTIVATION CENTERS THAT CAN BE OPENED IN ANY ONE WARD. 5AM - 2/8

REAL ESTATE MOGUL DONALD TRUMP IS ABOUT TO LEAVE HIS MARK ON THE NATION'S CAPITAL. TRUMP WON A BID TO RE-DEVELOP THE OLD POST OFFICE PAVILION ON PENNSYLVANIA AVENUE. HE PLANS TO CONVERT THE BUILDING INTO A 250-ROOM LUXURY HOTEL WITH RESTAURANTS AND A SPA. BUT TRUMP SAYS HE STILL PLANS TO KEEP THE BUILDING'S HISTORIC FEATURES.

THE NEXT MOST VALUABLE CHAIN: TIFFANY'S-- WHICH TAKES IN ABOUT 40 PERCENT LESS THAN APPLE.

THE FUNDRAISER FOR THE D-C 'HABITAT FOR HUMANITY'--- WILL AID THE MISSION TO BUILD AND REHAB LOCAL HOMES. THE GROUP ALSO HOPES TO SEND A DELEGATION TO HAITI, TO HELP WITH REBUILDING EFFORTS THERE. OUR SENIOR POLITICAL CORRESPONDENT SCOTT THUMAN EMCEE'D THE EVENT .

HEALTH & HEALTH CARE

5AM - 2/16

A UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND, BALTIMORE COUNTY STUDENT MAY BE INFECTED WITH TUBERCULOSIS. OFFICIALS SAY THE STUDENT HAS BEEN ISOLATED FOR FURTHER TESTING. THE SCHOOL ALSO SAYS IT IS NOTIFYING PEOPLE WHO MAY HAVE COME IN CONTACT WITH THAT STUDENT... SO THEY CAN BE TESTED FOR THE DISEASE. HOWEVER... THE UNIVERSITY SAYS IT IS DIFFICULT TO CONTRACT TUBERCULOSIS THROUGH TYPICAL CAMPUS LIFE.

12PM - 2/28

IT COULD BE A KEY DAY IN THE FIGHT SURROUNDING ABORTIONS IN VIRGINIA. THE SENATE DELAYED A VOTE YESTERDAY ON A BILL THAT WOULD REQUIRE WOMEN SEEKING ABORTIONS TO HAVE AN ULTRASOUND EXAM. THE BILL INCLUDES AN AMENDMENT THAT REQUIRES ONLY *EXTERNAL* ABDOMINAL ULTRASOUNDS INSTEAD OF A VAGINAL PROBE. THE CHANGE DID *NOT* PLACATE ABORTION RIGHTS ACTIVISTS AND OTHERS. REPUBLICAN LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR BILL BOLLING COULD HOLD THE TIE-BREAKING VOTE WHEN SENATORS CAST THEIR BALLOTS.

5PM - 1/24

A BILL TO *END* THE REQUIREMENT FOR GIRLS IN VIRGINIA TO BE VACCINATED AGAINST H-P-V -- IS A STEP CLOSER TO LAW. THE LEGISLATION SAILED THROUGH A REPUBLICAN-CONTROLLED HOUSE COMMITTEE. SUPPORTERS OF ENDING THE MANDATE SAY IT SHOULD BE UP TO PARENTS AND DOCTORS TO DECIDE WHETHER GIRLS GET THE VACCINE AGAINST THE SEXUALLY TRANSMITTED H-P-V -- BEFORE THE SIXTH GRADE. THE DISEASE CAN LEAD TO CERVICAL CANCER.

A NEW MEDICAL MARIJUANA SUPERSTORE IS SET TO OPEN IN THE DISTRICT THIS FRIDAY. BUT THE 'WE-GROW' STORE--- LOCATED ON RHODE ISLAND AVENUE-- WILL *NOT* SELL MARIJUANA-- ONLY GROWING SUPPLIES. THE OPENING COMES THE SAME DAY D-C LAWMAKERS WILL ANNOUNCE WHO WILL GET MEDICAL MARIJUANA PERMITS. THE DISTRICT JOINED 16 STATES, BY LEGALIZING MEDICAL MARIJUANA USE IN 2010.

11PM - 1/17

THE DEBATE OVER MEDICAL MARIJUANA INTENSIFIES IN THE DISTRICT TONIGHT-- AS THE D-C COUNCIL PASSES EMERGENCY LEGISLATION AIMED AT ALIEVATING CONCERNS. SOME CIVIL RIGHTS ACTIVISTS WANT TO ABOLISH THE DEATH PENALTY IN MARYLAND. N-DOUBLE-A-C-P PRESIDENT BENJAMIN JEALOUS AND MARYLAND CIVIL RIGHTS LEADERS WILL HOLD A NEWS CONFERENCE THIS MORNING IN ANNAPOLIS. THEY PLAN TO HIGHLIGHT WHAT THEY CALL RACIAL DISPARITIES AND SYSTEMIC FLAWS IN CAPITAL PUNISHMENT IN MARYLAND AND NATIONALLY.

THE BILL BEING CONSIDERED BY THE D-C COUNCIL WOULD LET GAY COUPLES THAT MARRIED IN D-C GET DIVORCED -- *EVEN* IF THEY NO LONGER LIVE IN THE CITY. RIGHT NOW, ONE MEMBER OF THE COUPLE HAS TO LIVE IN D-C FOR SIX MONTHS BEFORE STARTING DIVORCE PROCEEDINGS. THE DISTRICT BEGAN ISSUING MARRIAGE LICENSES TO SAME-SEX COUPLES IN MARCH 20-10.

5PM - 1/23

WASHINGTON COULD BE THE NEXT STATE TO LEGALIZE GAY MARRIAGE. TODAY, A DEMOCRATIC SENATOR ANNOUNCED SHE'LL SUPPORT THE MEASURE---BECOMING THE 25TH VOTE PASS THE BILL OUT OF THE SENATE. HOUSE LEADERS ALREADY HAD ENOUGH SUPPORT. WASHINGTON WOULD BECOME THE SEVENTH STATE TO LEGALIZE SAME-SEX MARRIAGE.

EDUCATION

5AM - 1/13

THE PUBLICATION, "EDUCATION WEEK" IS OUT WITH ITS ANNUAL RANKINGS OF PUBLIC SCHOOLS. AND MARYLAND SCHOOLS ARE FIRST IN THE NATION.. FOR THE FOURTH YEAR IN A ROW. "EDUCATION WEEK" GIVES MARYLAND AN OVERALL GRADE OF "B-PLUS." MASSACHUSETTS, NEW YORK, AND VIRGINIA ARE NEXT.. WITH A "B" AVERAGE. D.C. SCHOOLS HAVE A "C-MINUS" AVERAGE.

5AM - 1/26

A NEW STUDY COULD RE-IGNITE A MAJOR DEBATE OVER PUBLIC EDUCATION IN THE DISTRICT. THE WASHINGTON POST REPORTS A NEW STUDY RECOMMENDS THAT THE CITY TURN AROUND OR CLOSE MORE THAN THREE-DOZEN TRADITIONAL PUBLIC SCHOOLS IN ITS POOREST NEIGHBORHOODS. THE REPORT ALSO RECOMMENDS THAT THE CITY EXPAND THE NUMBER OF HIGH-PERFORMING CHARTER SCHOOLS.

5AM - 3/21

THE D-C COUNCIL HAS APPROVED THE MOST SWEEPING **EDUCATION** REFORM LEGISLATION IN YEARS. THE LAW MAKES D-C THE FIRST IN THE NATION TO REQUIRE STUDENTS TO APPLY TO COLLEGE OR TRADE SCHOOL...AND TAKE THE S-A-T OR A-C-T TEST. TEACHERS WOULD GET ANNUAL BONUSES FOR RELOCATING TO POOR, STRUGGLING SCHOOLS. AND D-C WILL INCREASE EFFORTS TO IDENTIFY AND PROVIDE INTERVENTIONS FOR AT-RISK STUDENTS.

12PM - 2/9

THE CAMPAIGN IS EXPECTED TO REINFORCE THE LINK BETWEEN SCHOOL ATTENDANCE AND ACADEMIC SUCCESS.

THE DAYS OF CONTINUING TEACHER CONTRACTS IN VIRGINIA COULD BE COMING TO AN END. THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES HAS APPROVED LEGISLATION THAT WOULD MAKE IT EASIER TO REMOVE PUBLIC SCHOOL **TEACHERS** FROM THEIR JOBS. CURRENTLY **TEACHERS** SPEND THREE YEARS ON PROBATION AND THEN RECEIVE A CONTINUING CONTRACT. THE BILL WOULD ELIMINATE THE PROVISION AND REQUIRE ANNUAL EVALUATIONS. THE SENATE WILL NOW CONSIDER THE LEGISLATION.

EMPLOYMENT & ECONOMY

4:30AM - 3/15

PRINCE GEORGE'S AND MONTGOMERY COUNTY LEADERS WILL UNVEIL THEIR 20-13 BUDGET PROPOSALS TODAY. PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY EXECUTIVE RUSHERN BAKER WILL RELEASE A PLAN THAT ADDRESSES AN EXPECTED 126-MILLION DOLLAR BUDGET SHORTFALL. MONTGOMERY COUNTY EXECUTIVE IKE LEGGETT WILL OUTLINE A PLAN TO DEAL WITH AN EXPECTED 135-MILLION DOLLAR BUDGET HOLE.

5AM - 2/1

NINE-THOUSAND NEW JOBS ARE EXPECTED IN FAIRFAX COUNTY.. WITHIN THE NEXT YEAR. THAT'S THE WORD FROM THE COUNTY'S ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY. IT SAYS THE NEWLY CREATED JOBS WILL COME FROM 159 DIFFERENT COMPANIES. AMONG THEM IS BECHTEL CORPORATION. IT RECENTLY ANNOUNCED IT WOULD MOVE ITS GLOBAL OPERATIONS HEADQUARTERS FROM FREDERICK.. INTO FAIRFAX COUNTY.

5AM - 3/7

TODAY, D.C. MAYOR VINCENT GRAY WILL UNVEIL A NEW TWO-MILLION DOLLAR ON-THE-JOB TRAINING PROGRAM. IT WILL BE FUNDED WITH LOCAL DOLLARS. THE DISTRICT WILL PAY 90-PERCENT OF A PARTICIPANTS SALARY DURING THE TRAINING PERIOD. THERE'S ALREADY A SIMILAR PROGRAM FUNDED WITH FEDERAL DOLLARS.. THAT WILL EXPIRE IN JUNE.. TARGETING THE LONG-TERM UNEMPLOYED. THE NEW PROGRAM WILL ALLOW MORE RECENTLY UNEMPLOYED RESIDENTS TO PARTICIPATE.

5PM - 3/15

TAXPAYERS IN MARYLAND COULD SOON PAY EVEN MORE -- IF THE STATE SENATE GETS ITS WAY. THE DEMOCRATIC-CONTROLLED SENATE PASSED BUDGET LEGISLATION TODAY THAT *INCREASES* INCOME TAXES FOR MOST TAXPAYERS. TWELVE REPUBLICANS AND EIGHT DEMOCRATS VOTED AGAINST IT. THE BILL WAS CHANGED TO COLLECT *MORE* MONEY FROM COUPLES WITH AN INCOME OF MORE THAN 500-THOUSAND DOLLARS.
