We have completed our review of your response submitted on behalf of *Bonneville International Corporation*, licensee of the above-referenced stations, to the June 10, 2014 random audit letter sent to it in accordance with the provisions of 47 C.F.R. Section 73.2080(f)(4) of the Commission's Equal Employment Opportunity (EEO) rules.

As a result of our review, we find that no further action is required. In accordance with Section 73.3526(e)(10) of the Commission's rules for commercial stations, or Section 73.3527(e)(11) for noncommercial stations, copies of this letter, our audit letter, and the audit response must be placed in the stations' public inspection files to remain until grant, by final order, of the next renewal application of the license for the station to which the file relates.

Additionally, pursuant to Section 73.3526(e)(10) of the Commission's rules for commercial stations or Section 73.3526(e)(11) for noncommercial stations, the licensee must upload copies of this letter, our audit letter, and its audit response in the station's online public inspection file. The materials must remain in the online public file until the next grant of the renewal application, by final order, of the license for the station.
