Pensacola Mayor Grover Robinson is donating his Mayor's salary to help the city with its Coronavirus response. He asked the city to donate the money to Pensacola Energy and Sanitation Services, to help people who are out of work and need help paying their bills.

The City of Pensacola is keeping their public Parks open but are reminding park visitors to observe safe social distancing. They're advising visitors not to use playground equipment, park benches and other shared public surfaces. Frequently touched surfaces are not being disinfected.

With local schools closed due to the pandemic, Escambia County libraries are partnering with "Feeding the Gulf Coast" to provide free curbside pickup meals for children ages 18 and younger.

Many services are considered crucial during the Pandemic, among them medical, public safety and food distribution. Today Okaloosa County Commissioners heard from those in the building industry who asked to be included as essential, saying it's important that they continue to have access to permits and inspections. Commissioners did not take action on the request, but they did vote to extend the County State of Emergency for another week.

The Okaloosa School District today began handing out Chromebooks today to students for online learning. Superintendent Marcus Chambers said over 17,000 devices will have been handed out by tomorrow, and the District is also working to get internet access to families who need it.

Currently, 38 employees of the Escambia County Sheriff's Office are in self-quarantine. 21 are deputies and 17 are employees of other departments. They have no cases of COVID-19 but are acting out of an abundance of caution. Some are self-quarantining because they had travelled to "hot spots".

The battle over closing beaches in Escambia County may resurface next week. Last week, Commissioner Robert Bender said the beaches would stay open, but the next day the Commission voted to shut them down. Today, Commissioner Jeff Bergosh went live on Facebook with the County Administrator and County Health Director Dr. John Lanza, explaining that he voted to close the beaches after receiving a letter from Dr. Lanza and the CEOs of area hospitals expressing concern over the crowds and lack of social distancing.
