\*\*\* Presidential candidates from both parties are taking a stance on important issues affecting Americans every day. Immigration reform has taken center stage at many rallies across the country. Both sides agree some form of immigration reform is needed, but they disagree on the way some of the candidates are looking to fix the problem. Reporter David Gonzalez spoke with Dorothy Davis, chairman of Escambia County Republican party, who said this issue is not immigration; it's illegal immigration. She credits Donald Trump's hard stance on illegal immigration for his quick rise to the front of the GOP pack. However she doesn't think his push to end birthright citizenship will happen. "It's a constitutional amendment. You'd have to amend the amendment or do away with the amendment." Local resident Grace Resendez McCaffery believes immigration has become an easy target for presidential hopefuls. She's disappointed in those candidates who have called children born to illegal immigrants "anchor babies", which she feels is a derogatory term. When asked if she considered the term to be derogatory, Davis said, "I don't consider it derogatory. It's descriptive."
