* No decision was made at Thursday night's Escambia County Commission meeting, but it was the topic of a lengthy discussion. The project designed to reduce flooding around Lake Charlene is at a standstill and about \$2 million in federal grants is at stake. The county and the home owner's association have not been able to come to terms about a piece of property needed for the project. The \$2.1 million flood gate replacement for Lake Charlene would increase water flow and lower the lake level by nine inches. That could prevent the flooding of the 300 homes in the area. In January, Commissioner Doug Underhill sought eminent domain, so the county could take a parcel of land for an easement. However, other commissioners would not support that. The HOA has proposed an easement agreement, but the county attorney said because of the stipulations in the plan, they can't go along with the terms. The project is supposed to be finished by next March under terms of the FEMA grant. Underhill said if the HOA and the county can't come to an agreement soon, they could lose the federal money.

**** Pensacola Mayor Grover Robinson says it is an issue that could take years to fix and is even calling out some of the prior work as inadequate. "We're stuck with drainage problems and we have no money," said Robinson. For years, any time there has been heavy rain, the downtown area floods. According to a city spokesperson, last year the city spent nearly \$18 million to resurface more than 2,000 blocks of city roads. "The city did a lot of resurfacing work without thinking about what they are going to do with drainage," Mayor Robinson said. Mayor Robinson says the main issue is that these things take time and money to expand and fix. He says it's something the city doesn't have in their budget right now. "That's going to cost millions of dollars. We've taken basically eight more years of our gas tax money and we spent it all on that resurfacing project that was done in prior administration," said Robinson. Business owners say although the city has done work to improve roads in the area there should be more done to stop the overflow of rainwater.

***** The Escambia County Commissioners are demanding answers after an internal complaint was made against Escambia County EMS by its medical director. The internal complaint and investigation was the first thing brought up at Thursday's Commissioners workshop. Several Commissioners demanded action following our Channel 3 Investigation bringing the issues to light. Channel 3 News obtained a letter written by Medical Director Dr. Rayme Edler; the County said it received the complaint and forwarded it to the Florida Department of Health, which is part of what sparked the state-level investigation. Dr. Edler made numerous allegations from medicine dosing errors across EMS protocols, IV certifications missing signatures, and her biggest concern she said is some falsified EMT credentials and certifications. The acting County Administrator Amy Lovoy announced she's bringing in an outside party next week to assess the entire Public Safety Department. She said that person will be former County Public Safety Director Janice Kilgore, who worked with the County for 36 years. Commissioners Jeff Bergosh and Robert Bender, during Thursday's meeting, said they want to see the Florida Department of Health complete its investigation before taking any direct actions.

*22 During Thursday's Escambia County Board of Commissioners meeting, commissioners finalized the contract for incoming County Administrator Janice Gilley. According to the final contract obtained by Channel 3 News, Gilley will make \$185,000 salary with a \$500 monthly car allowance and usual health and retirement benefits. Commissioners showed unanimous support for the deal Thursday. In comparison, her predecessor, Jack Brown, took over in 2014 as administrator with around a \$150,000 salary and left his position with a \$191,000 salary. Brown had previous experience as a county administrator, Gilley does not, but there are many different factors, unknown in this case, that can contribute to salary negotiations. Chairman Lumon May said going in the county was looking for a salary between \$170,000-\$190,000. Without specifying, May said Gilley wanted more than what was finally agreed upon. Gilley will have several issues to deal with immediately, from a Florida Department of Health investigation into EMS to several recent high-level resignations. May sees those resignations as a chance for Gilley to get a fresh start and build the best team for her. "She will have the opportunity to sit with me in negotiations and in the hiring process to shape the future of the county for the next 20 to 25 years," May explained.

*24 With a \$4 toll each way for cars, the Mid-Bay Bridge isn't cheap – considering how many people use it. Okaloosa County commissioners would like to see some relief for those that use it daily. "Employers maybe should give a voucher to their folks that come across the bridge day in and day out," said Commissioner Carolyn Ketchell. "Maybe Okaloosa Transit could provide a direct bus back and forth twice a day." The Bridge Authority says tolls get annual reviews based on revenues and right now many who use the bridge still get away without paying. "We lose 20 percent of our revenue from nonpayment - people going through the tolls without paying," said Gordon Fornell with Mid-Bay Bridge Authority. Those without the annual SunPass beat the system if tags are obstructed by dirt or things like bike racks, but it is out-of-towners driving in the SunPass line – then ignoring mailed notices to pay up - that are the bigger problem. Commissioner Graham Fountain, who used to work with the Department of Transportation, suggests looking into how to track violators. "We had cooperative agreements with every state. That if a driver or co-owner didn't pay their fee, we sent it to the state and suspended their driver's license," Fountain explained. There is nothing in place to do that now, but the Bridge Authority promises to consider all options.

*28 Summer vacation began Friday for students in Santa Rosa and Okaloosa counties, but in one community that coincides with the recent closing of a neighborhood park. Residents are calling on the county to do something. The Sylvania Heights Community, just outside of the Fort Walton Beach city limits, has one park. It's a half-acre on formerly church-owned land that was on a 20-year lease to the county. It now belongs to Opportunity Place, a shelter for women and families. Their future plans do not include keeping the park. It's a concern of those who live nearby. The shelter cites rundown equipment safety concerns as reasons for recently shutting the park down. "We are concerned about the children in the community, it's a liability," said Opportunity Place's Executive Director Debra McDaniel. With the park lease expiring, the county must review its options - negotiating a new lease and fixing up this park or building a new park. Okaloosa County Commissioner Trey Goodwin says the county is working on a solution. Organizers of the Save Our Park effort are encouraging citizens to contact commissioners. They say it's all about the kids. There is a demonstration near the park scheduled for Saturday, June 8, at 4 p.m. The county hopes to schedule a community meeting about the park in the next few weeks.

*34 Florida Governor Ron DeSantis has signed a controversial bill into law, banning sanctuary cities across the state. He signed the bill in front of a crowd of supporters and next to some of his Republican lawmaker colleagues in Okaloosa County Friday morning. "Sanctuary cities" are cities that do not cooperate with federal immigration authorities, particularly regarding undocumented inmates. Gov. DeSantis said the law is about the rule of law and public safety. He was joined by Congressman Matt Gaetz and Senator Doug Broxson - who praised his efforts. However, the signing wasn't done without protests. Outside the event, a small group of protesters held signs reading things like "Immigrants make America Great." We talked to a protester named Aliza Sager about her position. "They're asking for our local tax dollars to go and fund the police to act as a hand of the federal government instead of to act as the police for this area," Sager said. Okaloosa County Commissioner Graham Fountain said this was the first time a governor signed a bill within the county. The new law is expected to be contested in court.

After months of getting input from the community they have identified two key projects that will transform the downtown area: Bruce Beach and the Hashtag Connector. Gene Worth with SCAPE said that they want to create Bruce Beach into a destination by adding in more amenities. They want to commemorate the African American history and heritage in the area with an education center. They also want to add more picnic areas, a learning garden and kayak storage. Councilwoman Jewel Cannada-Wynn expressed the importance of having the center surrounded around education instead of just a community center. The second project is the hashtag connector. To make these streets more pedestrian and cyclist friendly they've suggested reducing the size of car lanes to make room for bike lanes and more trees. Cedar street could become a shared road plaza that can easily be shut down for pedestrians during special events. James Lima, Planning + Development, said the potential economic impact these projects could have in Pensacola is more than \$13 million in new tax revenue with these new changes.
