Family Life Today

7/12-13/18 - Guest Dr. Winfred Neely shared biblical wisdom for how to deal with stress and worry.

7/16-17/18 - Josh Mulvihill explained with the Bible has to say about sex and marriage, and reminded parents that they must start early teaching and modeling a biblical view of marriage for their children.

7/18-20/18 - Ron and Nan Deal discussed how they regained their footing and strengthened their marriage as they grieved the loss of their son.

7/23-24/18 - Author Hanna Seymour gave advice for young women preparing for college and talked about what they can expect when they get there, like college pressures, drugs, roommates and more.

8/6-8/18 - Brian Housman addressed the concerns of parents regarding their children on the internet, about cyber bullying, cyber porn, and video gaming and gave practical advice for keeping their kids safe on the web.

9/5-7/18 - Dennis and Barbara Rainey shared their wisdom about what they learned over the past 28 years parenting their six now grown children.

9/27-28/18 - Teen researcher David Eaton encouraged parents to talk to their kids about appropriate cell phone usage, and challenged parents on what to discuss with your kids before giving them a cell phone.
