It’s the first time in the Union’s history that it has struck all three automakers at the same time.

Making it difficult for Americans to keep up with bills and discouraging potential homeowners.</p>

State Representative and Physician Dr. Joel Rudman says the doctor shortage has been building for about a decade. He says part of the problem is non-compete clauses. He says that keeps doctors from switching jobs in a specific area and forces them to move away if they leave a job. Rudman says he is working on a bill to make that clause illegal.</p>
