



ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
CALIENTE COMMUNITY METHODIST CHURCH

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That a corporation sole is hereby formed under the provisions of Nevada Compiled Laws 1929, paragraphs 3223 to 3230, inclusive, as amended by Statutes of 1941, page 91, to acquire, hold or dispose of church or religious society property, for the benefit of religion, for works of charity, and for public worship.

ARTICLE I.

The name of the corporation by which it shall be known is the " CALIENTE COMMUNITY METHODIST CHURCH".

ARTICLE II.

The object of the corporation is and shall be to facilitate the acquisition, holding or disposition of church or religious society property, for the benefit of religion, for works of charity, and for public worship.

ARTICLE III.

The estimated value of the property at the time of making these Articles is \$19,000.00.

ARTICLE IV.

The title of the undersigned person making these Articles is "Lay-Leader and Chairman of Official Board", the undersigned being the Trustee-in Trust duly chosen and elected, as Lay-Leader and Chairman of Official Board, in conformity with the constitution, canons, rites, regulations or discipline of the Methodist Church, and in whom shall be vested the legal title to property held for the purposes, use or benefit of said Caliente Community Methodist Church, said property at present being formerly acquired and held in the name of Caliente Community Methodist Church, and conveyed to the undersigned for the purpose of creating a corporation sole by the duly chosen and acting trustees of said "Caliente Community Methodist Church", in compliance with resolution duly adopted at a meeting of the lay members in the City of Caliente, in the County of Lincoln, in the State of Nevada, on November 11, 1961. It is required by the rules, regulations or discipline of said

Methodist Church that, in the event of the occurrence of a vacancy, by the death, resignation or removal of the incumbent Lay-Leader and Chairman of the Official Board, the vacancy shall be filled for the balance of the unexpired term by the Board of Trustees. By-Laws governing the election of members of the Board of Trustees and other officers, their term and their duties and powers may be made and amended at any regular or special meeting of the church members held pursuant to not less than ten days written notice of the time, place and object thereof, unless the By-Laws otherwise provide.
