

2024-2026 MANDATORY CARRIAGE AND  
CHANNEL POSITION ELECTION STATEMENT  
FOR STATION WAGV(TV)

This Statement constitutes the election for the three-year period beginning January 1, 2024, pursuant to Section 76.64 and/or Section 76.66 of the Rules of the Federal Communications Commission (“FCC”), by **Living Faith Ministries, Inc.**, licensee of **Station WAGV(TV), Harlan, Kentucky** (the “Station”), for mandatory carriage by the multichannel video programming distributors listed below whose system(s) serve those communities, counties, and any unincorporated areas within such communities and counties in the **Knoxville, Tennessee Designated Market Area** or within the Station’s “television market” as set forth in Section 76.55(e) of the Rules of the FCC, including any modifications thereto pursuant to Section 76.59 of the Rules of the FCC.

This election is effective for the period beginning January 1, 2024, and terminating as of December 31, 2026.
