Trouble on the Tracks

A train derailment in East Palestine, Ohio earlier this year exposed serious deficiencies in the country's safety review process for trains. The disaster served as a warning for the country on the potential impact of railroad safety inspection cuts. Spotlight on America Correspondent Duane Pohlman examines why these cutbacks have safety experts concerned another catastrophe could be just around the bend.

Insurance Delays & Denials

With natural disasters increasing in intensity and frequency, more homeowners are running into delays and denials getting their insurance claims paid. It's part of a disturbing nationwide trend, and it's leaving many people desperate and frustrated.
