SHELBY CITY COUNCIL APPROVES REZONING REQUEST FOR 1,600 HOMES

A MASSIVE HOUSING DEVELOPMENT IN SHELBY IS MOVING FORWARD. IT WOULD BE ONE OF THE BIGGEST IN THE CITY'S HISTORY. OUR PARTNERS AT THE SHELBY STAR REPORT CITY COUNCIL VOTED TO APPROVE A REZONING REQUEST TO BUILD 1,600 NEW HOMES ALONG HIGHWAY 74. IT'S AN 835-ACRE SITE NEAR OLD BOILING SPRINGS ROAD. NEIGHBORS EXPRESSED CONCERNS ABOUT TRAFFIC DURING A PUBLIC HEARING MONDAY. ANOTHER VOTE IS REQUIRED FOR THE REZONING REQUEST. IF APPROVED, THE DEVELOPMENT WOULD BE BUILT IN PHASES OVER TEN YEARS.

CHARLOTTE CITY COUNCIL TO DECIDE ON FUTURE OF SALOON SITE

CHARLOTTE CITY COUNCIL WILL MAKE A DECISION TUESDAY ON THE FUTURE OF THE TWO BUCK SALOON SITE IN THE BELMONT NEIGHBORHOOD. DEVELOPER CLACHAN PROPERTIES IS ASKING CITY COUNCIL TO REZONE THE LAND SO MORE CAN BE BUILT THERE. AN ATTORNEY FOR THE PROPERTY OWNER SAYS THEY ARE EXPLORING REDEVELOPMENT OPTIONS, BUT THEY EXPECT THE TWO BUCK SALOON TO REMAIN A PART OF THE COMMUNITY FOR THE FORESEEABLE FUTURE.

CITY COUNCIL TO MAKE DECISION ABOUT DEVELOPMENT PROPOSAL IN CHARLOTTE

TOMORROW, CHARLOTTE CITY COUNCIL WILL DECIDE WHETHER TO APPROVE A MAJOR PROJECT NEAR THE HEART OF PLAZA MIDWOOD. LEVINE PROPERTIES WANTS TO DEVELOP A VACANT LOT AT COMMONWEALTH AND THE PLAZA. THE DEVELOPER REDUCED THE BUILDING'S HEIGHT FROM 150 TO 126 FEET. THE PLAN CALLS FOR UP TO 175 APARTMENTS, 12,000 SQUARE FEET OF RETAIL AND A DRIVE-THRU FOR THE CHARLOTTE FIREFIGHTERS CREDIT UNION.

CITY COUNCIL LOOKS AT FUNDING CHALLENGES

THIS WEEK, CHARLOTTE CITY COUNCIL IS GIVING YOU A CHANCE TO HEAR WHAT THEY BELIEVE ARE PRIORITIES FOR THIS YEAR'S BUDGET. BUT MAYOR VI LYLES SAYS THAT MIGHT BE CHALLENGING. COUNCILWOMAN AT LARGE DIMPLE AJMERA BELIEVES THAT'S PARTIALLY BECAUSE THE CITY HASN'T RAISED THE SALES TAX IN FIVE YEARS. A PROPERTY TAX INCREASE IS ONE POSSIBILITY. A SALES TAX INCREASE IS ALSO ON THE TABLE. THE CITY WILL HOST WORKSHOPS THROUGHOUT THE SPRING BEFORE TAKING A VOTE AT THE END OF JUNE.

CITY COUNCIL TO VOTE ON LEASE FOR COFFEE SHOP IN PARKING DECK

A NEW COFFEE SHOP IS COMING TO A UNIVERSITY CITY PARKING DECK. CHARLOTTE CITY COUNCIL WILL VOTE MONDAY TO LEASE SPACE IN THE JW CLAY PARKING DECK TO MARIB COFFEE COMPANY. THE CITY SAYS THE COFFEE AND PASTRY SHOP WILL GET A 63-MONTH LEASE WITH A 5-YEAR RENEWAL OPTION. RENT WILL BE \$4,900 A MONTH.

CITY COUNCIL TO VOTE ON BRIDGE YEARS IN THE MAKING

TOMORROW, WE EXPECT CITY COUNCIL TO VOTE ON A LONG-PLANNED BRIDGE OVER I-85 IN NORTH CHARLOTTE. THE \$27 MILLION PROJECT NEAR LOUIS ROSE PLACE WAS ORIGINALLY PLANNED TO HAVE ARCHES, BUT THOSE ARE BEING CUT TO SAVE MONEY. THE CITY STARTED PLANNING THIS BACK IN 2017. OFFICIALS BLAME EXTENSIVE UTILITY RELOCATION FOR THE DELAYS. THE BRIDGE IS EXPECTED TO OPEN IN 2028.

PENALTIES TO RETURN FOR "NUISANCE" ORDINANCES

STARTING MARCH FIRST, THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE IS BRINGING BACK PENALTIES FOR A HANDFULL OF "NUISANCE" ORDINANCES. THEY INCLUDE MISDEMEANORS FOR OPEN CONTAINERS, SLEEPING IN PARKS, PUBLIC URINATION AND LEWD ACTS. THE CITY IS ALSO INSTALLING PORTA-TOILETS AND WORKING WITH NONPROFITS THAT SERVE THE HOMELESS. FEBRUARY 14, 2024 7:00PM

RENT AT WEST CHARLOTTE APARTMENTS TO REMAIN AFFORDABLE

RENT WILL STAY AFFORDABLE AT A WEST CHARLOTTE APARTMENT COMPLEX THANKS TO A MOVE FROM CHARLOTTE CITY COUNCIL. EARLIER THIS WEEK, CITY LEADERS UNANIMOUSLY APPROVED A 20-YEAR, \$800,000 AFFORDABLE HOUSING LOAN FOR THE TYVOLA CROSSING APARTMENTS. THE MOVE WILL KEEP RENT AT OR BELOW 50% OF RESIDENTS' AVERAGE MEDIAN INCOME. THE COMPLEX AT WEST BOULEVARD HAS A WAITLIST OF UP TO 2 YEARS.

LINCOLNTON LEADERS APPROVE NEW SOCIAL DISTRICT

LINCOLNTON CITY LEADERS APPROVED THE PLAN TO BRING A SOCIAL DISTRICT TO THE AREA. THE CITY COUNCIL APPROVED THE PROPOSAL ON A TIE-BREAKER VOTE LAST NIGHT, 4-3. THE PROPOSED DISTRICT WOULD TAKE UP ROUGHLY FOUR BLOCKS OFF EAST MAIN STREET. THE SOCIAL DISTRICT ALLOWS RESIDENTS TO WALK AROUND IN PUBLIC WHILE DRINKING ALCOHOL.

HEARING PLANNED FOR APARTMENT PROPOSAL

MONDAY, PEOPLE CAN WEIGH IN ON A PROPOSED SOUTH CHARLOTTE APARTMENT DEVELOPMENT, LESS THAN A THOUSAND FEET AWAY FROM AN EAGLES' NEST. THE EAGLES RECENTLY HAD BABIES. A DEVELOPER IS PROPOSING 640 APARTMENTS AND TOWNHOMES OFF REA ROAD NEAR ELM LANE. NEIGHBORS ARE CONCERNED HOW THE DEVELOPMENT WILL IMPACT THE BIRDS. DOZENS OF SPEAKERS ARE EXPECTED AT MONDAY'S CITY COUNCIL MEETING.

CITY COUNCIL SIGNS OFF ON MIDTOWN CHARLOTTE DEVELOPMENT

A MAJOR MIDTOWN DEVELOPMENT PROJECT JUST GOT THE GREEN LIGHT FOR ITS FINAL PHASE. THE CHARLOTTE CITY COUNCIL APPROVED PLANS YESTERDAY FOR A MULTI-FAMILY TOWER. IT WILL SIT ON PEARL PARK WAY AT KENILWORTH AVENUE. THE CHARLOTTE BUSINESS JOURNAL REPORTS THE PROJECT WILL HAVE 425 UNITS INCLUDING 10 RENT-RESTRICTED UNITS. THE PROJECT'S FINAL PHASE ALSO INCLUDES A HOTEL, OFFICE AND RETAIL SPACE. CONSTRUCTION STARTS NEXT YEAR. MARCH 25, 2024 7:00AM

COUNCIL TO GET UPDATE ON CHARLOTTE HORNETS PRACTICE FACILITY

TODAY CHARLOTTE CITY COUNCIL WILL GET AN UPDATE ON THE CHARLOTTE HORNETS PRACTICE FACILITY. WE TOLD YOU LAST MONTH THAT THE TEAM SAYS IT WANTS TO BUILD ITS NEW FACILITY ON A GRAVEL LOT IN BETWEEN THE SPECTRUM CENTER AND POLICE HEADQUARTERS. THE CITY PLANS TO NEGOTIATE AN AGREEMENT THAT WOULD ALLOW \$30 MILLION TO GO TOWARDS IMPROVEMENTS AT THE SPECTRUM CENTER AND ANOTHER \$30 MILLION FOR THE CITY'S INVESTMENT IN THE NEW FACILITY DEVELOPMENT. TODAY, A UNION COUNTY SOCCER COACH IS EXPECTED TO FACE A JUDGE ON CHARGES OF INDECENT LIBERTIES WITH A CHILD. MONROE POLICE ARRESTED JORGE PALMA IN OCTOBER. HE'S THE OWNER OF THE UNION SOCCER ACADEMY ON NELVA ROAD. INVESTIGATORS SAY HE ASSAULTED TWO TEENAGE GIRLS AT THE ACADEMY. OTHER PLAYERS HAVE COME FORWARD SAYING HE TOOK ADVANAGE OF THEM TOO.

NEW DEVELOPMENTS IN A DEADLY SHOOTING IN NORTHWEST CHARLOTTE. POLICE SAY THE PERSON KILLED AT A PARTY ON WEST TRADE STREET OVERNIGHT IS 17-YEAR-OLD AVYON THOMAS AND THE SUSPECT IS ALSO A TEEN. WE LEARNED THOMAS WAS A SENIOR AT MYERS PARK HIGH SCHOOL. OFFICERS SAY 18-YEAR-OLD JAMIR EASTER IS THE SUSPECT AND TURNED HIMSELF IN TONIGHT. HE'S FACING AN INVOLUNTARY MANSLAUGHTER CHARGE.

TWO ARRESTED, ACCUSED OF STEALING MAIL

TWO PEOPLE ARE BEHIND BARS, ACCUSED OF STEALING MAIL FROM DOZENS OF UNION COUNTY BUSINESSES. POLICE ARRESTED STEPHANIE AUBAS AND JAMES MCINTYRE MONDAY. OFFICERS STOPPED A SUSPICIOUS VEHICLE OFF STALLINGS ROAD AND INDUSTRIAL DRIVE. THEY SAY THEY FOUND LOADS OF STOLEN MAIL FROM ACROSS UNION COUNTY. THERE ARE 28 VICTIMS IN STALLINGS ALONE. POLICE SAY THE SUSPECTS TOOK THE MAIL RIGHT OUT OF MAILBOXES.

WOMAN SAVES MOTHER FROM KNIFE ATTACK IN GROCERY STORE

POLICE SAY A WOMAN'S DAUGHTER SAVED HER LIFE AFTER A MAN HELD HER AT KNIFEPOINT IN A NORTH CHARLOTTE FOOD LION GROCERY STORE. IT HAPPENED YESTERDAY MORNING AROUND 10:30 AT THE NORTH GRAHAM STREET STORE. POLICE ARRESTED ROBERT MCQUEEN. THEY SAY THE VICTIM WAS SHOPPING WHEN MCQUEEN GRABBED HER AND PUT A KNIFE TO HER THROAT. OFFICERS SAY HER DAUGHTER HEARD HER SCREAM, RUSHED OVER AND PUNCHED MCQUEEN. THEY SAY MCQUEEN LET THE WOMAN GO AND RAN AWAY, BUT CUT THE WOMAN'S HAND AS HE RELEASED HER. POLICE ARRESTED MCQUEEN IN THE STORE'S BREAK ROOM.

FAMILY SAYS TEEN KILLED IN SHOOTING HAD A BRIGHT FUTURE

SOMEONE TOOK A 17-YEAR-OLD'S LIFE IN A DEADLY SHOOTING IN WEST CHARLOTTE. NOW, WE'RE LEARNING MORE ABOUT MELAKAH CORBETTE'S BRIGHT FUTURE THAT WAS TRAGICALLY CUT SHORT. POLICE SAY HE WAS SHOT MUTIPLE TIMES ON PITTS DRIVE AROUND 1-15 THURSDAY MORNING. HIS AUNT SAYS HIS FAMILY IS STILL TRYING TO WRAP THEIR HEADS AROUND THE TRADEGY. SHE SAYS THE JULIUS L. CHAMBERS HIGH SCHOOLER RECENTLY SIGNED TO A MODELING AGENCY IN NEW YORK. POLICE HAVEN'T RELEASED ANY MORE DETAILS ABOUT THE SHOOTING.

MAN IN CRITICAL CONDITION AFTER SHOOTING OUTSIDE SHOPPING CENTER

POLICE SAY A ROCK HILL MAN IS IN CRITICAL CONDITION AFTER SOMEONE SHOT HIM OUTSIDE A SHOPPING CENTER. POLICE SAY THE VICTIM WAS SHOT EARLY SATURDAY MORNING AS HE WALKED OUT OF "HARTLAND'S BAR" ON DAVE LYLE BOULEVARD. DETECTIVES SAY THEY INTERVIEWED PEOPLE AT THE RESTAURANT AND THERE WERE NO FIGHTS OR ANY INDICATION THERE WOULD BE A SHOOTING. OFFICERS SAY THEY FOUND ONE SHELL CASING IN THE PARKING LOT. BUT WITH NO VIDEO, POLICE SAY THEY ARE STILL LOOKING FOR INFORMATION.

MAN SHOT BY POLICE DURING ARREST ISSUED BOND

A JUDGE ISSUED A \$60,000 BOND FOR THE MAN SHOT BY POLICE IN WEST CHARLOTTE AFTER THEY SAY HE PULLED A GUN ON THEM. TIMOTHY MOORE FACES SEVERAL CHARGES IN CONNECTION TO THE SHOOTING LAST THURSDAY OFF BEATTIES FORD ROAD. IN COURT TODAY, PROSECUTORS SAID AN OFFICER WAS ON PATROL, WATCHING A CAMERA SYSTEM, WHEN HE SAW MOORE, WHO IS A FELON, PULL OUT A PISTOL IN A "TAUNTING MANNER" WHILE TALKING TO A DRIVER. HE TOLD ANOTHER OFFICER WHO WENT UP TO MOORE AND SHOT HIM AFTER THEY SAY HE PULLED A GUN. WE LEARNED MOORE HAS TWO OTHER PENDING CHARGES RIGHT NOW INCLUDING ASSAULT WITH A DEADLY WEAPON FROM A 2022 CASE.

MAN CHARGED IN DEADLY BREAK-IN

POLICE ARRESTED A MAN FOR A 2023 BREAK-IN THAT ENDED WITH ONE PERSON KILLED. NICKALEAU FELDER IS CHARGED WITH MURDER AND ROBBERY. POLICE SAY HE SHOT AND KILLED JONATHAN SHEFFIELD. A FAMILY MEMBER FOUND HIM DEAD INSIDE A NORTHEAST CHARLOTTE HOME LAST MARCH.

POLICE IN WADESBORO ARE ASKING FOR THE PUBLIC'S HELP TO FIND A MURDER SUSPECT. DEWON HAILEY IS CHARGED WITH MURDER IN A DEATH THAT HAPPENED EARLY WEDNESDAY MORNING. DETAILS FROM LAW ENFORCEMENT REMAIN LIMITED, BUT WE ARE WORKING TO LEARN MORE. IF YOU KNOW WHERE HAILEY IS, CALL POLICE.

MAN ACCUSED OF SECRET PEEPING BANNED FROM BOJANGLES COLISEUM

A MAN ACCUSED OF SECRET PEEPING IN THE BATHROOM AT THE BOJANGLES COLISEUM IN EAST CHARLOTTE IS NOW BANNED FROM THE ARENA. THE CHARLOTTE REGIONAL VISITORS AUTHORITY, WHICH RUNS THE COLISEUM, SAYS JOHN CUTTER CAN NO LONGER ATTEND EVENTS THERE. ACCORDING TO POLICE, A FATHER SPOTTED CUTTER USING A CAMERA TO SPY ON PEOPLE IN THE RESTROOM DURING A CHARLOTTE CHECKERS HOCKEY GAME. CUTTER FACES MORE THAN A DOZEN FELONY CHARGES AND IS OUT OF JAIL ON BOND.

WOMAN PLEADS NO CONTEST TO EMBEZZLING FROM CHURCH

A CATAWBA COUNTY WOMAN IS EXPECTED TO SERVE 4-6 YEARS IN PRISON. SHE PLEADED NO CONTEST TO STEALING MORE THAN HALF A MILLION DOLLARS FROM THE CHURCH WHERE SHE WORKED. DURING HER PLEA YESTERDAY, LISA MCCOOL APOLOGIZED TO THE HIGHLAND BAPTIST CHURCH IN HICKORY, AS WELL AS HER FAMILY. POLICE SAID SHE TRANSFERRED MONEY FROM THE CHURCH'S ACCOUNTS TO HER ACCOUNTS. INVESTIGATORS SAY SHE USED THE MONEY TO FUND HER LAVISH LIFESTYLE. THE JUDGE ALSO ORDERED HER TO PAY BACK ALMOST \$400,000. THERE'S A HEARING SET FOR MAY TO TALK ABOUT ANOTHER \$200,000 IN RESTITUTION. JANUARY 2, 2024 7:00PM

MONROE EXPRESSWAY TOLLS GOING UP

YOU'LL NOW HAVE TO PAY MORE TO USE THE MONROE EXPRESSWAY. THE NORTH CAROLINA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION SAYS, AS OF YESTERDAY, THE ANNUAL TOLL RATE INCREASE WENT UP 8 CENTS TO \$2.85. THAT'S NEARLY A 3% INCREASE FOR DRIVERS THAT HAVE AN NC QUICK PASS. THE RATE INCREASE PAYS OFF BONDS THAT WERE SOLD TO FUND THE TOLL LANES AS WELL AS OVERALL MAINTENANCE WHICH INCLUDES GENERAL REPAIRS, MOWING AND WINTER WEATHER PREP.

WORKERS TO BE LAID OFF AT CHARLOTTE DOUGLAS AIRPORT

CHANNEL NINE UNCOVERED A FEDERAL LAWSUIT ALLEGING JUVENILE DETENTION CENTERS IN NORTH CAROLINA ARE VIOLATING THE U.S. CONSTITUTION BY KEEPING KIDS IN SOLITARY CONFINEMENT. THE LAWSUIT ACCUSES THE CABARRUS REGIONAL JUVENILE DETENTION CENTER OF HOLDING CHILDREN IN SMALL CELLS FOR 23 HOURS A DAY OR MORE FOR WEEKS OR EVEN MONTHS WITHOUT ANY VALID REASON. IT GOES ON TO CLAIM SOME CHILDREN ARE FACING INHUMANE RESTRICTIONS SUCH AS PUTTING THE FLAP DOWN ON THE SMALL WINDOW ON THEIR DOOR SO THEY CANNOT SEE OUT OF THEIR CELL OR TURNING OFF THE WATER SO THEY CANNOT FLUSH THE TOILET OR USE THE SINK. WE REACHED OUT TO THE NORTH CAROLINA DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY. A SPOKESPERSON SAID "THE DEPARTMENT DOES NOT COMMENT ON PENDING LITIGATION AND WILL NOT COMMENT ON CLAIMS CONTAINED WITHIN THIS LAWSUIT." THEY ADDED "UNDER STATE LAW, INFORMATION CONTAINED WITHIN JUVENILE RECORDS IS CONFIDENTIAL AND NOT CONSIDERED TO BE PUBLIC INFORMATION."

INMATES WITH WEAPONS TAKE OVER JUVENILE DETENTION CENTER

A GROUP OF JUVENILE INMATES WITH WEAPONS TOOK OVER THE CABARRUS YOUTH DEVELOPMENT AND DETENTION CENTER AND IT WASN'T THE FIRST DANGEROUS INCIDENT THIS WEEK. THE NORTH CAROLINA DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY SAYS IT STARTED SUNDAY NIGHT WHEN A GROUP REFUSED TO RETURN TO THEIR ROOMS. MONDAY NIGHT IN THE SAME UNIT, OFFICIALS SAY A YOUNG INMATE ASSAULTED A STAFF MEMBER, STOLE THEIR KEYS AND ALLOWED OTHER JUVENILES OUT OF THEIR ROOMS. ONE JUVENILE INMATE WAS HURT DURING THAT TAKEOVER. OFFICIALS SAY STAFFING AND OVERCROWDING ARE FUELING THESE ISSUES.

NEIGHBORS SAY LANDFILL IN THEIR COMMUNITY STINKS

NEIGHBORS ARE UPSET ABOUT A STRONG SMELL FROM A LANDFILL IN CABARRUS COUNTY. WE FIRST TOLD YOU ABOUT THE ISSUES NEAR THE ROCKY RIVER CROSSING COMMUNITY LAST SUMMER. NOW NEIGHBORS SAY IT'S GETTING WORSE. WE WERE TOLD LAST JUNE THE DIVISION OF AIR QUALITY ISSUED A NOTICE TO THE LANDFILL, REQUIRING AN ODOR MANAGEMENT PLAN. IT CITED THE NUMBER OF COMPLAINTS AND 'CONCERNING ODOROUS EMISSIONS COMING FROM THE SOLID WASTE LANDFILL.' THE DIVISION OF AIR QUALITY SAID THE PLAN NEEDED TO BE FULLY IMPLEMENTED BY THE END OF LAST YEAR. BUT NEIGHBORS SAY THEY HAVEN'T NOTICED THE SMELL GETTING ANY BETTER. THE LAST DOCUMENTED SMELL COMPLAINT WAS FROM LAST NOVEMBER. THE DIVISION OF AIR QUALITY VISTED THE SITE, BUT FOUND NO VIOLATIONS AND NOTED THE LANDFILL APPEARED TO BE FOLLOWING THE APPROVED ODOR PLAN.
