IT AIRS ON KCNS 7:00 AM - 8:00 AM MONDAY TO THURSDAY, AND 7:00 AM – 7:30 AM FRIDAY. RICHARD FRENCH CAME TO BROADCASTING FROM THE WORLD OF POLITICS AND HAS BEEN AT RNN SINCE ITS INCEPTION. THE SHOW BRINGS ATTENTION TO NEWS EVENTS AND THE SOCIETAL AND POLITICAL ISSUES OF THE DAY.

- RNN LOCAL NEWS IS A WEEKLY HALF-HOUR BROADCAST FOCUSING ON LOCAL AND NATIONAL NEWS STORIES COVERING IMPORTANT ISSUES, EVENTS, AND MUCH MORE THAT INTERESTS AND IMPACTS THE COMMUNITY. RNN LOCAL NEWS AIRS ON KCNS FRIDAYS 7:30 AM – 8:00 AM.

DURING THE 2ND QUARTER OF 2022, KCNS COVERED THE FOLLOWING ISSUES OF PUBLIC IMPORTANCE, SELECTED BY THE STATION PURSUANT TO ITS CONTINUING ASCERTAINMENT EFFORTS AS PROBLEMS, NEEDS, AND INTERESTS OF ITS VIEWERS WITHIN THE STATION SERVICE AREA WARRANTING TREATMENT BY RNN'S PUBLIC AFFAIRS PROGRAMMING, RICHARD FRENCH LIVE, AS WELL AS THROUGH PUBLIC SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENTS.

TOPICS OF PUBLIC INTEREST COVERED BY KCNS- RICHARD FRENCH LIVE PROGRAMMING INCLUDE (BUT NOT LIMITED TO):

- **HEALTH:** *Issues relating to general health, medical conditions, healthy lifestyles, and healthcare, as well as the Covid-19 Pandemic, its medical aspect, vaccines, vaccination, boosters, and new variants, but also implications to the economy, lifestyle, travel, education, and everyday life of the American people. Attention was given this quarter to Covid and masking updates, vaccinations/boosters, Medicare, cost of healthcare, and Monkeypox.*
- **ECONOMIC AND CIVIC AFFAIRS:** *All aspects affecting the life of the communities, the status of the economy, economic development, infrastructure, transportation, parks and recreation, housing, and the broader civic affairs spectrum of issues including racism, bias, inequality, worker rights, jobs/employment, and police conduct. This quarter attention was given to President Biden's FY2023 Budget, proposed Billionaire Tax, inflation and the economy, unionization of Amazon and Starbucks, student debt, trade with China, rising housing costs and gas prices, price gouging, supply chain issues, food shortages and baby formula shortage, Gay Pride Month, Federal Reserve raising interest rates.*
- **ENVIRONMENTAL AND ENERGY CONCERNS:** *That which affects the planet and quality of life for all people from issues including air, water, soil, and land pollution, global warming and climate change, waste disposal, deforestation, natural disasters and more. Attention was given this quarter to the continued funding of fossil fuels v promoting clean American energy, impact of climate change on our youth.*
- **GOVERNMENT and POLITICS:** *Various aspects of the American political life, government regulations, general and military affairs, from nominations to the gestation process of new laws, bills, and executive orders. This quarter attention was given to the January 6th Commission/hearings/public hearings, state of Democracy in the U.S., War in Ukraine, Russia/Putin, war crimes committed in Ukraine, confirmation of Judge Jackson, Democratic v Republican politics, Supreme Court, Roe v Wade, Former President Trump, and his influence over GOP politics, Social Security, SCOTUS, and Concealed Carry Laws.*
- **ELECTIONS:** *All political elections and nominations including focus on the candidates, polls, and voting. This quarter attention was given to voting rights, the Black vote, and primary and mid-term elections.*

- **CRIME, TRIALS, AND POLICE ACTIVITY:** *Latest criminal cases, murders, mass shootings, kidnappings, protests, prison system, including coverage of local, national, and international police, court delinquency and related activities. This quarter attention was given to Former President Trump's legal woes in New York and on January 6th, gun violence and mass shootings in America, Texas school shooting, gun control.*
- **EDUCATION:** *Topics examining that which affects education and learning. This quarter attention was given to violence in schools, Uvalde school shooting, and student loan debt.*
- **COMMUNITY INTEREST:** *Any event, situation of social interest for one or more of the communities to which the show is available. This quarter attention was given to the death of Eric Boehlert, Journalist, Founder of Press Run Media, and critic of mainstream media and conservative news.*
- **IMMIGRATION:** *U.S. Immigration Policy with attention given to the Crisis at the U.S. Southern Border and Texas Governor Abbott (R) policy regarding migrants at the Texas/Mexico border.*
