1. Rio Grande Foundation Bob Flotte, Host
Broadcast live and local on January 4, 2018 from 7:32 am – 8:00 am
Paul Gessing, the President of Rio Grande Foundation, spent some time talking about New Mexico 2018 30-day session. Mr. Gessing, again, highlighted the importance of passing Right to Work Legislation during the session. He discussed that one other county, in our state, was considering passing their own ordinance.
2. Candidate for Congress District #2 Bob Flotte, Host
Broadcast live and local on January 5, 2018 from 9:03 am – 9:28 am
Mr. Monty Newman, Candidate, was live in our studio presenting his story on why he is running for Congress District #2. Mr. Newman stated his experience as a businessman, in Hobbs New Mexico and running a successful business, and how that relates to running a successful Washington. He shared why our listeners should consider him as the prime candidate.
3. Pre-Earth Day Information Bob Flotte, Host
Broadcast live and local on January 11, 2018 from 7:28 am – 7:50 am

Manon are met from the District #2 office, which includes all of Otero County, discussed Highway 54-70 reconstruction between Alamogordo and Tularosa.
