**STORY:** SCHOOL GUARD

**DATES:** 1/3/12 (7PM)

**SYNOPSIS:** TWO SCHOOL SECURITY GUARDS IN JAIL TONIGHT -- ACCUSED OF STEALING FROM THE VERY SCHOOL THEY WERE SUPPOSED TO BE PROTECTING. EIGHT LAP-TOPS, AND SEVERAL CELL PHONES. THE TWO GUARDS WORKED FOR A COMPANY THAT MONITORS ALARMS FOR ST. LOUIS CITY PUBLIC SCHOOLS, AFTER-HOURS. THEY ALLEGEDLY BROKE INTO FANNING MIDDLE SCHOOL, SATURDAY NIGHT.

**STORY:** MO & IL BEST SCHOOLS

**DATES:** 1/4/12 (4PM)

**SYNOPSIS:** MISSOURI AND ILLINOIS... BOTH LAND ON KIPLINGER'S LIST OF 100 BEST VALUES IN PUBLIC COLLEGES. BASED ON IN STATE TUITION... THE UNIVERSTIY OF NORTH CAROLINA CHAPEL HILL TOOK THE TOP SPOT WITH 17 THOUSAND DOLLARS A YEAR FOR TUITION. TRUMAN STATE RANKED 23RD AND IS THE BEST LOCAL VALUE COSTING 15 THOUSAND A YEAR. THE UNIVERSITY OF ILLINOIS AT URBANA CHAMPAIGN RANKED 27, WITH TUITION AT 25 THOUSAND A YEAR. THEN, THE UNIVERISTY OF MISSOURI COLUMBIA RANKED 79TH, COSTING AN AVERAGE OF 19 THOUSAND A YEAR.

**STORY:** KC SCHOOLS

**DATES:** 1/6/12 (4PM, 7PM), 1/8/12 (7PM)

**SYNOPSIS:** EDUCATION FUNDING IS ON THE TOP OF MISSOURI LAWMAKERS TO DO LIST DURING THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY THIS YEAR. AND NOW THE UNACREDITED KANSAS CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT IS BEING CALLED ONE OF THE WORST IN THE NATION. THE CITY'S MAYOR SAYS HE GOT THE ASSESSMENT FROM THE U-S SECRETARY OF EDUCATION.... AND SAYS HE WAS STARTLED BY THE NUMBERS.

**STORY:** SCHOOL TAX HIKE

**DATES:** 2/1/12 (4PM)

**SYNOPSIS:** THE PRICE FOR HIGHER EDUCATION MAY BE GETTING HIGHER FOR SOME SCHOOLS IN THE SHOW ME STATE. THE UNIVERSITY OF MISSOURI MAY RAISE IN-STATE TUITION BY 7 POINT 5 PERCENT AT THE COLUMBIA CAMPUS. UMSL... WOULD GO UP BY 8 POINT 2 PERCENT AND ROLLA WOULD GO UP 9 PERCENT. THE PROPOSED HIKE ARE DUE TO STATE BUDGET CUTS. THE TUITION HIKE WOULD ALSO AFFECT OUT OF STATE STUDENTS.

**STORY:** WESTBORO PROTEST AT FORT ZUMWALT

**DATES:** 2/5/12 (7PM)

**SYNOPSIS:** SOME PARENTS ARE CONCERNED ABOUT TWO PLANNED PROTESTS AT TWO AREA HIGH SCHOOLS TOMORROW. A CHURCH GROUP KNOWN FOR ITS MESSAGES OF HATE PLANS TO PROTEST OUTSIDE CLAYTON AND FORT ZUMWALT EAST HIGH SCHOOLS. NEWS 11'S JEFF BERNTHAL HAS MORE DETAILS FROM ST. PETERS WHERE PARENTS HAVE CONCERNS.

**STORY: WESTBORO CLAYTON PROTEST**

**DATES:** 2/6/12 (4PM, 7PM)

**SYNOPSIS:** THE FOGGY MORNING DIDN'T STOP HUNDREDS OF CLAYTON HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS FROM GETTING A REAL LIFE CIVICS LESSON... PROTESTING THE CONTROVERSIAL WESTBORO BAPTIST CHURCH. FIVE WESTBORO MEMBERS...WERE GREETED WITH MESSAGES OF LOVE AND UNITY IN FRONT OF THE SCHOOL. WESTBORO BAPTIST MEMBERS CARRIED SIGNS AGAINST ABORTION.. AND AGAINST GAYS. THE GAY STRAIGHT ALLIANCE FROM CLAYTON HIGH ORGANIZED THE COUNTER DEMONSTRATION... TO PREACH TOLERANCE FOR ALL.

**STORY: JOPLIN SCHOOL DEMOLITION**

**DATES:** 2/6/12 (7PM)

**SYNOPSIS:** IT'S BEEN 9 MONTHS SINCE A KILLER TORNADO TOUCHED DOWN IN JOPLIN.... DESTROYING HUNDREDS OF HOMES, BUSINESSES AND SCHOOLS. THE CITY'S HIGH SCHOOL WAS DESTROYED AND STUDENTS NOW GO TO CLASS IN AN EMPTY MALL. BUT WHAT'S LEFT OF THE HIGH SCHOOL BUILDING IS ABOUT TO COME DOWN. DEMOLITION WORK BEGINS EARLY NEXT WEEK. A TOTAL OF 5 SCHOOLS WERE DESTROYED BY THE TWISTER... SEVERAL OTHERS WERE DAMAGED.

**STORY: ROBOTICS COMPETITION AT PARKWAY**

**DATES:** 3/3/12 (7PM)

**SYNOPSIS:** THE COMPETITION AT PARKWAY NORTH HIGH SCHOOL WAS FURIOUS WITH A TRIP TO "L-A" POTENTIALLY ON THE LINE. THAT MAY SOUND LIKE THE "AMERICAN IDOL" AUDITIONS AT SCOTT TRADE CENTER. NEWS 11'S ANDY BANKER REPORTS, THIS WAS MORE LIKE THE "AMERICAN IDOL" OF ROBOTICS.

**STORY: TURNER VS CLAYTON CASE**

**DATES:** 3/5/12 (NOON)

**STORY: JACOLOGY – SCHOOL TRANSFERS**

**DATES:** 3/7/12 (4PM)

**STORY:** FLORISSANT SHOOTING

**DATES:** 1/2/12 (NOON)

**SYNOPSIS:** ONE MAN IS FIGHTING FOR HIS LIFE AFTER A SHOOTING AND CARJACKING OVERNIGHT IN NORTH CITY. RIGHT NOW, AUTHORITIES ARE STILL SEARCHING FOR A SUSPECT. NEWS 11'S CHRIS REGNIER IS DOWNTOWN AT POLICE HEADQUARTERS WITH THE LATEST ON THE INVESTIGATION.

**STORY:** OFFICER INVOLVED SHOOTING

**DATES:** 1/10/12 (4PM, 7PM)

**SYNOPSIS:** A CHAOTIC SCENE IN NORHT ST. LOUIS THIS AFTERNOON... INVOLVING ST. LOUIS POLICE. OFFICERS SAY IT STARTED WHEN POLICE CAME UP ON A DRUG DEAL ALONG MARTIN LUTHER KING BOULEVARD. POLICE SAY THE SUSPECTS RAMMED TWO POLICE CARS.. TRYING TO GET AWAY... THEN HIT A PEDESTRIAN... AND DRAGGED THAT PERSON. OFFICERS FIRED SHOTS AT THE CAR AND HIT THREE PEOPLE INSIDE THE CAR.. BUT IT KEPT GOING.

**STORY:** BUSTAMANTE GUILTY PLEA

**DATES:** 1/11/12 (7PM)

**SYNOPSIS:** TEENAGE MURDER SUSPECT ALYSSA BUSTAMANTE-- PLEADED GUILTY TO SECOND DEGREE MURDER TODAY. SHE WAS WORKING A PLEA DEAL... SO THAT SHE WOULD NOT BE TRIED FOR FIRST DEGREE MURDER. IN COURT BUSTAMANTE TOLD THE JUDGE QUOTE "I STRANGLERED HER AND STABBED HER IN THE CHEST" END QUOTE. BUSTAMANTE WAS JUST 15-YEARS-OLD -- WHEN SHE MURDERED ELIZABETH OLTEN IN OCTOBER 2009 IN A RURAL TOWN NEAR JEFFERSON CITY.

**STORY:** ANTI VIOLENCE MARCH

**DATES:** 1/14/12 (7PM)

**SYNOPSIS:** WASHINGTON PARK RESIDENTS... CALLING FOR AN END..TO VIOLENCE..IN THEIR SMALL TOWN. FOUR PEOPLE..WERE KILLED THERE LAST MONTH. NEWS 11'S..BETSEY BRUCE REPORTS THE POLICE CHIEF WANTS HELP FROM THE PUBLIC TO SOLVE THE CRIMES.

**STORY: MO MALL SHOOTING**

**DATES:** 1/15/12 (7PM)

**SYNOPSIS:** SOME TENSE MOMENTS INSIDE AN INDEPENDENCE, MISSOURI MALL YESTERDAY AFTER AN ALTERCATION ENDED IN A SHOOTING. POLICE SAY A VERBAL ALTERCATION BETWEEN FOUR PEOPLE.. LED TO A FIGHT... AND THEN SOMEONE PULLED OUT A GUN AND STARTED FIRING. THE MALL WENT INTO LOCKDOWN - THOSE INSIDE... SAY THEY SPENT UP TO 15 MINUTES... IN LIMBO.

**STORY: FATAL SHOOTING**

**DATES:** 1/15/12 (7PM)

**SYNOPSIS:** A 32-YEAR-OLD MAN IS SHOT TO DEATH AND TWO OTHERS WOUNDED IN AN ATTEMPTED ROBBERY AT A HOME IN THE 43-HUNDRED BLOCK OF SWAN IN SOUTH ST. LOUIS. POLICE SAY SEVERAL MEN ENTERED THE HOME WHERE THE VICTIMS WERE AND OPENED FIRE. JERALD MASSEY WAS SHOT IN THE STOMACH AND LATER DIED. TWO OTHER VICTIMS WERE SHOT AS THEY RAN OFF BUT WILL RECOVER FROM THEIR WOUNDS. THE SUSPECTS ARE ON THE LOOSE.

**STORY: CRIME STATS**

**DATES:** 1/19/12 (7PM)

**SYNOPSIS:** POLICE IN BOTH SAINT LOUIS CITY AND COUNTY ARE HAPPY TO REPORT SERIOUS CRIME WAS DOWN IN 2011... FROM THE YEAR BEFORE. THE LOOP STRADDLES THE CITY-COUNTY DIVIDE ALONG DELMAR AND OVER SKINKER. POLICE IN BOTH AREAS ARE HAPPY REPORT 2011 SAW THE LOWEST NUMBERS OF SERIOUS CRIMES LIKE MURDERS, CAR THEFTS AND ARSONS IN FORTY YEARS.

**STORY: POLICE SHOOTING LAWSUIT**

**DATES:** 2/6/12 (7PM)

**SYNOPSIS:** A WRONGFUL DEATH LAWSUIT... SCHEDULED TO BE FILED AGAINST THE ST. LOUIS POLICE DEPARTMENT. IT'S FOR THE DEATH OF 24-YEAR-OLD ANTHONY LAMAR SMITH. BACK IN DECEMBER INVESTIGATORS SAY HE DROVE AT AN OFFICER -- WHO TRIED TO STOP HIM DURING A SUSPECTED DRUG DEAL. THAT OFFICER OPENED FIRE... KILLING SMITH. THE LAWYER FILING THE SUIT FOR SMITH'S 1-YEAR-OLD DAUGHTER CLAIMS HE WAS UNARMED... AND THAT POLICE PLANTED A GUN ON HIS BODY AFTER THE SHOOTING... TO JUSTIFY THEIR ACTIONS.

**STORY: ROAD RAGE SHOOTING**

**DATES:** 2/7/12 (7PM)

**SYNOPSIS:** A NEWS 11 FOLLOW UP TONIGHT. CONCERNING THE SHOOT OUT AND POSSIBLE CASE OF ROAD RAGE NEAR MERAMEC CAVERNS AN 18 YEAR OLD MAN HAS BEEN CHARGED WITH FIRING SEVERAL SHOTS AT A FATHER AND HIS TWO YOUNG DAUGHTERS. NEWS 11'S ROCHE MADDEN IS IN STANTON MISSOURI WITH THE LATEST.

**STORY: JEFF CO HOMICIDE**

**DATES:** 2/16/12 (7PM)

**SYNOPSIS:** MURDER INVESTIGATION IS UNDERWAY IN JEFFERSON COUNTY AFTER A MAN'S BODY WAS FOUND IN THE BED OF A PICKUP TRUCK. THE TRUCK HAD ACTUALLY BEEN IN FULL VIEW ALL WEEK ON MORSE AVENUE. BUT NO ONE KNEW THERE WAS A DEAD MAN IN THE TRUCK BECAUSE HIS BODY WAS WRAPPED IN A TARP. THE JEFFERSON COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT HAS NOT RELEASED HIS NAME YET OR SAY HOW HE DIED.

**STORY: FRIEND SHOOTS FRIEND**

**DATES:** 2/23/12 (7PM)

**SYNOPSIS:** A ST. LOUIS MAN FACES MURDER CHARGES TONIGHT.. AFTER SHOOTING A BALLWIN TEEN. THE TEEN WAS SHOT IN A CAR ON TUESDAY NIGHT. THE SUSPECT TOLD POLICE.. THE VICTIM ASKED HIM TO PULL THE TRIGGER. NEWS 11'S MICHELLE ANSELMO SPOKE WITH THE VICTIMS FAMILY AND HAS MORE DETAILS FROM BALLWIN.

**STORY: STOP THE VIOLENCE RALLY**

**DATES:** 2/25/12 (7PM)

**SYNOPSIS:** EAST ST. LOUIS..POLICE CHIEF..SAYS IT'S TIME FOR A CHANGE...SENSELESS VIOLENCE WILL NOT BE TOLERATED. FOX 2'S..TERESA WOODARD REPORTS - YOUNG AND OLD...ARE ON THE WAR-PATH..WITH HIM FOR THE STOP THE VIOLENCE RALLY.

**STORY: FATAL EAST ST. LOUIS SHOOTING**

**DATES:** 3/11/12 (7PM)

**SYNOPSIS:** TWO SHOOTINGS IN TWO DAYS OUTSIDE EAST ST. LOUIS NIGHTCLUBS....ONE OF THEM DEADLY. AS NEWS 11'S TERESA WOODARD REPORTS ... TONIGHT THE MAYOR IS MAKING TEMPORARY CHANGES TO THE CITY'S LIQUOR LAWS, AS A FAMILY IS GRIEVING AGAIN.

**STORY: OFFICER SHOOTING**

**DATES:** 3/23/12 (4PM)

**SYNOPSIS:** TWO TEENS NOW FACE CHARGES OF SHOOTING A ST. LOUIS POLICE SERGEANT AFTER INVADING HIS RIVERVIEW HOME THURSDAY.... AND APPARENTLY THEY USED HIS OWN GUN DURING THE CRIME. THESE PROBABLE CAUSE STATEMENT SAYS "THE DEFENDANTS FORCIBLY STOLE A 9 MM HANDGUN IN THE POSSESSION OF SGT. RICHMOND LINGARD. POLICE SAY CHRISTOPHER GALES AND MONTEZ THOMAS REPORTEDLY SHOT HIM IN THE STOMACH AND THE MANHUNT WAS ON.

**STORY: FLIP FLOP BANK ROBBERY**

**DATES:** 3/27/12 (7PM)

**SYNOPSIS:** AN ILLINOIS WOMAN FACES FEDERAL CHARGES AFTER POLICE SAY SHE ALLEGEDLY ROBBED HER HOMETOWN BANK AT GUNPOINT. THE WOMAN RAN FROM THE BANK WEARING FLIP-FLOPS..AND WAS CAUGHT JUST HOURS AFTER THE HOLD-UP. NEWS 11'S MICHELLE ANSELMO IS IN LEBANON.. WITH THE CLUES THAT LEAD TO HER QUICK ARREST.

**STORY: DOUBLE SHOOTING**

**DATES:** 3/27/12 (NOON)

**SYNOPSIS:** ST. LOUIS POLICE ARE SEARCHING FOR THE GUNMAN RESPONSIBLE FOR A DOUBLE SHOOTING THAT LEFT ONE PERSON DEAD. SHOTS WERE FIRED AROUND SEVEN O'CLOCK LAST NIGHT... ALONG UNION AND THEKLA IN NORTH ST. LOUIS. A YOUNG MAN WAS SHOT IN THE CHEST WHILE GETTING OUT OF HIS CAR... AND A STRAY BULLET HIT AN ELDERLY WOMAN IN THE LEG AS SHE SAT INSIDE HER HOME. THE MAN DIED...THE WOMAN IS EXPECTED TO SURVIVE.

**STORY: HOME INVASION**

**DATES:** 3/29/12 (4PM)

**SYNOPSIS:** A TERRIFYING HOME INVASION IN ST. CHARLES COUNTY ENDED IN GUNFIRE AND THE SUSPECT DEAD. THE DARDENNE PRAIRIE COUPLE NOTICED 20 YEAR OLD WILLIAM CARLTON PEERING INTO THEIR HOUSE THROUGH THEIR FRENCH DOORS. HE THEN THREW A BRICK THROUGH THE DOORS...BARGED IN...AND POLICE SAY BEGAN ASSAULTING THE COUPLE. THE HUSBAND GOT AWAY...GOT A HAND GUN..AND TELLS POLICE HE ORDERED CARLTON TO STOP. THE HOMEOWNER SAYS HE FIRED WHEN THE SUSPECT REFUSED...STRIKING THE MAN IN THE CHEST. CARLTON DIED AT A HOSPITAL.

**STORY:** NEW HEALTH CLUB- OVERWEIGHT ONLY

**DATES:** 1/6/12 (4PM), 1/8/12 (4PM)

**SYNOPSIS:** WANT TO STICK TO YOUR RESOLUTION TO LOSE WEIGHT... HERE'S A WAY ONE GYM FOUND TO OFFER SUPPORT TO THOSE SHY ABOUT GYMS. A HEALTH CLUB IN CHICAGO IS ONLY ALLOWING THOSE WHO ARE OVERWEIGHT TO JOIN. IT'S CALLED DOWNSIZE FITNESS AND IT OPENED LAST OCTOBER. THE OWNERS WANTED TO CREATE A COMFORTABLE ENVIRONMENT FOR PEOPLE WHO SHY AWAY FROM THE BIGGER GYMS. TO JOIN, YOU NEED TO BE AT LEAST 50 POUNDS OVERWEIGHT.

**DATES:** 1/9/12 (NOON)

**SYNOPSIS:** A STUDY REPORTED IN THE JANUARY JOURNAL OF THE AMERICAN COLLEGE OF CARDIOLOGY SAYS BRITISH RESEARCHERS FOUND THAT THOSE WHO SAT FOR MORE THAN 4 HOURS A DAY IN FRONT OF SCREENS WERE TWICE AS LIKELY TO BE HOSPITALIZED OR DIE FROM A MAJOR CARDIAC EVENT... **DATES:** 1/16/12 (NOON)

**SYNOPSIS:** THE CENTERS FOR DISEASE CONTROL IS ISSUING A REMINDER TO PEOPLE IN THE HEALTH CARE INDUSTRY. INSULIN PENS SHOULD NEVER BE REUSED ON MULTIPLE PEOPLE... EVEN IF THE NEEDLE IS CHANGED. THE PENS ARE USED TO INJECT PEOPLE WITH INSULIN. THEY CAN BE USED MULTIPLE TIMES... BUT THE C-D-C SAYS THEY SHOULD ONLY BE USED ON ONE PERSON. THE C-D-C REISSUED ITS WARNING AFTER IT SAYS IT GOT INCREASING REPORTS THAT THE PENS ARE BEING USED ON MULTIPLE PATIENTS.

**STORY:** ILLINOIS HELPS

**DATES:** 1/16/12 (7PM)

**SYNOPSIS:** THE STATE OF ILLINOIS IS LOOKING FOR VOLUNTEERS IN CASE OF A MAJOR DISASTER OR PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY. VOLUNTEERS WOULD SIGN UP FOR A STATEWIDE DATABASE CALLED "ILLINOIS HELPS."
