### **Finances**

October 16, 2023 At 6pm for 30 minutes we had a panel of financial experts field phone calls for our listeners about money and finances.

### **Mental Health**

He offered a compassionate look at mental illness, which affects one in five teens and adults in the United States. He discussed the need for overcoming the stigma of reaching out for help and encouraged the church community to offer hope and healing for families with loved ones suffering with mental health issues.

November 8, 2023 Ran an interview at 9:30am for 25 minutes with John Bornschein at 9:30 for 25 minutes. He is an author and pastor today, and he told how the process and decision his mother made to not have an abortion have impacted their family.

November 16, 2023 We aired a discussion with Julianna Goble at 8am for 25 minutes about the benefits of Foster care and how our audience could become foster parents.

### **Gaming and Teenagers**
