

The following is a list of some of the more significant community issues addressed by this station for the quarter specified. This listing is by no means complete, nor is the order in which these issues appear, intended to imply any degree of priority or significance of the issues.

1.

Education – Pala Mentoring Program – 1/1/2024 to 3/31/2024 – 2 times daily – 30 seconds - The Pala Band of Mission Indians has a mentoring program and this PSA provides perspective participants with information for joining the program.

2.

Culture – Basket Weaving Classes – 1/1/2024 to 3/31/2024 – 3 times daily – 15 seconds – The Cultural Center is providing classes. The classes provide an opportunity to learn the skill of an old practice and have some good social times.

3.

Culture – Dress Making Workshop – 1/1/2024 to 3/31/2024 – 3 times daily – 15 seconds – This PSA announces the workshop where you can learn the dress making culture that was so vital to the local community. Dress making was taught at the BIA Boarding Schools and the skills were used to provide for the families. Learn these skills at the Old Tribal Hall. The materials will be provided. Bring your own fabric if you like. Information at the Cupa Cultural Center.

4.

Education – Tutoring Classes – 1/1/2024 to 3/31/2024 – 3 times daily – 15 seconds – This PSA announces that there are lessons to improve math skills at the Pala Learning Center.

5.

Safety-Cyber Bullying - 1/1/2024 to 3/31/2024 – 1 time daily – 30 seconds – The AD Council shares this PSA to let parents and students know the signs and resources available for keeping individuals safe while so much time is now spent on the computer and online during this CoVid Pandemic.

6.

Family -Fatherhood - 1/1/2024 to 3/31/2024 – 1 time daily – 30 seconds – The AD Council shares this PSA to let fathers know the importance of being a father. This PSA also shares resource information for fatherhood.

7.

Economy - Financial Planning - 1/1/2024 to 3/31/2024 – 1 time daily – 30 seconds – The AD Council shares this PSA so families know information for financial planning resources. This information is very important to the Pala community.

8.

Safety-Food Prep - 1/1/2024 to 3/31/2024 – 1 time daily – 30 seconds – The AD Council shares this PSA to give information to the community about the importance of the proper preparation of food.

9.

Safety- Smokey Bear - 1/1/2024 to 3/31/2024 – 1 time daily – 30 seconds – Going away from forest fires these PSA's are directed at fire safety in the home during the coming winter months. The local community is given ideas to be safe while heating the house and keeping their heated system checked and clean.

10.

Safety-Texting and Driving - 1/1/2024 to 3/31/2024 – 1 time daily – 30 seconds – This PSA is a very nice audio presentation on the dangers of Texting while driving. It is directed at everyone but has a small mention asking young driver's to resist being distracted while driving.

11.

Safety – House Fires – 1/1/2024 to 3/31/2024 – 3 times daily – 30 seconds – during the winter months we air these announcements to keep our community aware of the dangers with overloading wires and recommend safe ways to keep a home warm.

12.

Safety – Emergency Preparation for Safety – 1/1/2024 to 3/31/2024 – 3 times daily – 30 seconds – During a time of year when there is a possibility of power outages or extreme weather this PSA identifies areas of consideration like food storage, backup power and other safety measures.

13.

Government – registrar of Voters – 1/22/24 to 3/4/2024 – 18 times daily – 30 seconds – These announcements are geared toward the importance of voting and recommendation on the different ways to vote this year.

14.

Social Justice – Democracy Now - 1/1/2024 to 3/31/2024 – 5 times weekly – 60 Minutes – This show is dedicated to social justice and pertains to protection of rights of the minority on all facets of government. The local Native American community represents 1% of the American population. This show brings to light many issues that concern the local community.

15.

Culture – Antonio Garra Day Broadcast – 3/16/2024 – 1 time – This event was broadcast live from San Diego Old Town in front of the First San Diego County Courthouse. It is a celebration of life for Capitan Antonio Garra. It is an event designed to share local Native American stories.

16.

Culture – Songs of the Southwest - 1/1/2024 to 3/31/2024 – once a week – 30 minutes – This show created by KPRI Rez Radio is dedicated to the music of southern California and the southwest. As you listen you learn of the history and nature of the music from the local area. The songs are sung in the local Native American languages.

17.

Health – Men's Health – 1/1/2024 to 3/31/2024 – 6 times daily – 30 seconds – This set of PSA's are provided by the AD Council and are directed at Men's Health. Many subjects are covered including Pre-diabetic symptoms. Diabetes and obesity are familiar problems in our community around Rez Radio, especially among the males.

18.

Education - 1/1/2024 to 3/31/2024 – 1 time daily – 30 seconds – This PSA is provided by Boostup.org. It provides information about resources that are available to prevent and recognize dropouts and keep students in school. This is an ongoing situation in our community.

19.

Safety – Kitchen safety - 1/1/2024 to 3/31/2024 – 3 times daily – With the current stay at home instructions, more people are cooking at home, so we provide information for kitchen safety.

20.

Safety – Tobacco dangers - 1/1/2021 to 1/31/2021 – 3 times daily – The Pala Tobacco Program provides these PSAs to present information on the dangers of tobacco use. These notifications include information about cigarettes and vaping. This is an on-going problem in our community.

21.

Cultural Issues – Native America Calling - 1/1/2021 to 3/31/2021 – 5 times a week – 60 minutes – Native America Calling is a call-in program that is dedicated to the issues of Native Americans in the United States. The show covers issues like culture, economic and legal situations. The local population is over 50 percent Native American or descendant of Native Americans or in a relationship with the Native Americans.

22.

Health – Mission San Antonio de Pala Broadcast - 1/1/2024 to 3/31/2024 – once weekly – 45 to 60 minutes – At the beginning of Co-Vid, the churches were closed for the community. An elder in the community asked if the Radio Station would broadcast mass for the community. After checking with the local Priest, community elders and the local ordinances, it was determined that we could do it. We at the radio station and in the community feel this broadcast helps with the health of the community both culturally and emotionally. We have been broadcasting mass ever since. The broadcast includes mass and a list of local community events. It also includes weather and radio events.

23.

Health – YANA Program - 1/1/2024 to 3/31/2024 – 3 times daily – 30 seconds – This PSA gives information for those in the Pala community that are staying at home during these trying times about the YANA program. YANA stands for You-Are-Not-Alone. It provides information for Pala Community members who want to be a part of a network that will keep in contact with older community members that are staying home. This program is formed in conjunction with the Pala Fire Department, Pala Band of Mission Indians and all community members.

24.

Family – Parenting - 4/1/2023 to 6/30/2023 – 12 times a month – 30 seconds – in our community we want to reinforce the idea of parenting. In these announcements it is noted that sometimes are children may remember a small fun family event that parents may not consider important. Parents will appreciate family events years later or maybe never, but the children often enjoy their childhood constantly. The importance of constant parenting. This series is the fatherhood series.
