April 2020 – June 2020

1. KKEA/K224FR airs a weekly public affairs program called “American Radio Journal” on Sundays from 4:30am-5:00am. These broadcasts cover many issues including but not limited to politics, economics, tax reform, civil rights, communication/social media, education, healthcare, and relief programs. (list of issues on the back of the document)

2. Fitness & Health KKEA/K224FR airs programming that promotes health, fitness, & nutrition.

“Orthopedic Update brought to you by Orthopedics Associates” is a :60 second vignette promoting sports medicine and treatment of sports injuries.

3. KKEA/K224FR broadcasts numerous public service announcement throughout the day to benefit local non-profit groups and our community. 501c3 groups as the National Kidney Foundation, Hawaii Bowl Foundation, Hawaii Speed and Quickness.

4. KKEA/K224FR broadcasts University of Hawaii “Manoa Minutes” are one-minute vignettes about a broad range of issues related to education, teachers, and community at-large. The vignettes are produced by the UH office of external affairs, as well as by University News.

5. Highway Safety KKEA/K224FR broadcasts traffic reports from the traffic center with Mahlon Moore during morning drive 6am-9:00am, and from in the afternoon from 4pm-6:30pm. A minimum of 20 reports air daily. Listeners are also advised of bad weather conditions that affect transportation on roadways for public safety.

6. Ocean safety – KKEA/K224FR broadcasts surf reports twice in morning and afternoon drive. The morning reports air at 7:30 a.m. and 8:30 a.m., and the afternoon reports air at 3:20 p.m. and 4:30 p.m.

7. Hawaii USA Bulletin Board – During “The Sports Animals” afternoon show, the hosts will read a PSA each day about a various sports or community event.

COVID-19

During the COVID-19 pandemic, ESPN Honolulu aired several one-minute news updates in the month of march to give local breaking news when it happened.

On March 16th, ESPN Honolulu began airing 1-minute CBS News Updates during non-local programming hours (10 a.m., 11 a.m., 1 p.m., 2 p.m.) on weekdays. Those updates largely focused on COVID-19, but covered other issues when necessary.

ESPN Honolulu's local shows (The Bobby Curran Show, The Josh Pacheco Show, The Sports Animals) gave pertinent updates when necessary during their hours (6-9 a.m., 12-1 p.m., 3-7 p.m.) Interviews with doctors, restaurant owners, and other necessary professionals affected by COVID-19 were brought on the air.

The Sports Animals aired a series of interviews with Dr. T, who owns a practice in Waikiki. The interviews took place on Fridays, beginning March 20th, and allowed listeners to ask questions to the guest.
