KJWP provided programming to the community that focused on the needs of the community of Jackson, Wyoming, the community in which the station was located, so long as it was operating. KJWP went silent on August 11, 2013, in preparation for its move to Wilmington, Delaware, in accordance with the reallocation of its channel and construction permit for modification of facilities, File No. BPCDT-20130528AIE, granted June 19, 2013. Its community-oriented programming included the following:

Community Calendar - Aired daily, Monday - Sunday, once each hour for 60 seconds. Each segment, which is updated periodically, discusses upcoming community educational, recreational, and charitable events, such as Habitat for Humanity building projects, the need for volunteers at the Teton Literacy Center, "Business Over Breakfast" at the National Museum of Wildlife Art, all of which address the issue of citizens' community involvement.

Adopt-a-Pet - A 30-second segment aired once per hour each day, Monday - Sunday. Each segment features a local pet available for adoption from the Animal Shelter and addresses issues related to pets and to the need for good homes for pets who might otherwise be left to roam freely through the community.
