AFFORDABLE HOUSING

Sky rocketing rent payments and housing shortages are among the varied concerns of residents of metro Atlanta.

CIVIL RIGHTS

The treatment of inmates inside Georgia's largest correctional facility was a huge focus of discussion in news and public affairs. The death of an inmate inside the psychiatric ward of the Fulton County Jail garnered worldwide attention and was a catalyst of actions to make improvements at the facility.

COMMUNITY EMPOWERMENT

Various guests discussed the multiple and intersected influences that determine the health, economic status, civic engagement, and general well-being of Black communities throughout Georgia. The importance of women collaborating in business, and the assistance provided to them is a focus of the community. Members of Southern Crescent Women in Business provided advice for acquiring success in business.

CRIME/PUBLIC SAFETY

Crime is up 60% in the City of Atlanta. Neighboring communities are also having to deal with the influx of crime. Millions of dollars from the federal government are being utilized to hire new officers and to make sure they have the necessary tools to get the job done. Mayor Andre Dickens discusses his plan to make a turnaround including opening a new police precinct in Buckhead, the process of hiring a new police chief, and activities to keep the city's youth off the streets. Atlanta City Councilwoman Keisha Waites discussed options being proposed to update a curfew in Atlanta as the city council prepares to vote.

EDUCATION

Various organizations discussed events that fund scholarship and mentoring programs.

ENVIRONMENT

Georgia Power provides energy saving tips to the community. The Chattahoochee River is a major source of water for the metro area. Efforts are consistently underway to maintain the cleanliness of the waterway. Communities are encouraged to assist in those efforts and to make good choices day-to-day about how they are helping keep the hooch clean. Audacy Atlanta has previously participated in Earth Day efforts by cleaning areas near the Chattahoochee River. This quarter Audacy Atlanta worked with Trees Atlanta to clear invasive plants.

HEALTH

Audacy produced and aired a special program centered around suicide. Mental health and addiction are also concerns of the community, heightened even more-so during the pandemic. Professional athletes are giving back to the community through events aimed at encouraging youth to stay health and fit, physically and mentally.

IMMIGRATION

The arm of the migration surge at the southern border has also reached Atlanta. According to statistics there have been record-breaking numbers of illegal crossings into the U.S. in recent months. Large groups of migrants continuously pour into Atlanta from a detention center in southwest Georgia.

PHYSICAL FITNESS

Various walks are held annually in Atlanta encouraging health and physical fitness. These include the Lupus Foundation Walk, which Maria Boynton hosts each year; the Parkinson Foundation's Optimist Walk, and the Fight for Air Climb. Various organizations continue to bring attention to diseases such as Sickle Cell, Kidney, via sports-related events.

VOTER EDUCATION

We continuously remind residents about the importance of voting and how/where to find the necessary information to assure that they are registered to vote. Our interviews also included groups that continue to educate the public about SB202 which was signed into law on March 25, 2021, by Georgia Governor Brian Kemp. Voting rights activists hope to educate the public about the measure which they call "Jim Crow 2.0". The push continues to encourage Congress to pass Voting Rights legislation as well.

Audacy Atlanta News Brand Manager & Public Affairs Director Dr. Maria Boynton has followed news and issues in local newspapers and on television/radio and held

discussions with community members and heads of organizations to determine which issues would be addressed during this quarter. The programs aired on WAOK were created to put WAOK's mission into action. WAOK reaches listeners in the greater Atlanta market covering Fulton, DeKalb, Cobb, Clayton and Gwinnett counties.
