Description:

The intern will work closely with the Development Department, and assist the Creative Services Team with its projects. The internship will focus on the concept, drafting, and production of graphic visuals for print and electronic use. Specific projects may include station-branded brochures, underwriting informational portfolio (media kit), DVD/CD packaging, and coverage map development. Additionally, the intern will be involved with brainstorming concepts for upcoming projects and marketing strategies. Schedule of hours will be flexible and may include some nights and weekends, but the intern must have availability weekdays during the normal business hours of 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM. WSKG's internships are learning experiences and are unpaid.

Qualifications:
