LOCAL NEWS

The WTTF News Department, with Director Steve Shoffner, provides extensive local news coverage. We provide listeners with news stories, interviews and public service announcements that address issues of concern to the local community.

Local news is broadcast Monday-Friday at 7:00, 8:00, 9:00 and 10:00 a.m. and again at 12:00, 4:00 and 5:00 p.m. plus other times as needed.

LOCAL INTERVIEWS

A number of weekday interviews were conducted from January to April 2023 and aired at 8:30 am or 12:30 pm the same day. The following is a summary:

• "County Corner" interviews

On most Thursday mornings, Seneca County officials are interviewed for approximately 5 minutes to update listeners on a variety of topics concerning the county. Guests included County Commissioners Mike Kerschner, Tony Paradiso, Bill Frankhart and Tyler Shuff plus other county officials.

• Tiffin Mayor

Tiffin Mayor Dawn lannantuono is interviewed the first Tuesday of every month and topics range from on-going projects to the budget to events in the city.

• The Ritz Theater

Michael Strong, Director of the Ritz Theater, stops by the studios on a regular basis to talk about the latest news and notes.

• Tiffin-Seneca Economic Partnership (T-SEP)

Donna Gross (Downtown Tiffin Main Street Manager) is interviewed every month by WTTF's Mike Roca concerning the progress on new and existing business and events happening in Downtown Tiffin.

• Seneca County Park District

Once or twice per month, a representative from the Seneca County Park District goes over the upcoming programs and events being offered.

• Tiffin-Seneca Public Library

Twice per month, a representative from the local library system calls in to report the latest news and programs.

LOCAL PUBLIC SERVICE

• "Tradio," WTTF's long-running community show, aired during the period on Mondays, Wednesdays and Friday from 9:00-10:00 a.m. This free show allows community members to buy, sell and trade items and ask for services.
