1. Community / Politics	Brown Bag Mornings	10/06	8:14am-8:28am	14mins	Brown Bag is joined by Maria Elena Durazo to discuss the Voz Voto Vida campaign. In order to encourage everyone in the community to vote. They discuss the upcoming elections, the big one being the presidential elections. Spoke on a bit of her own journey of how she got to the position she holds. Discuss migrant workers and the difficulties they endure and how we can change that. Brown Bag then directs the listeners to VosVotoVida.com for more details to assist them with information to vote.
2. Community / Health	Brown Bag Mornings	10/10	8:45am-8:50am	5mins	Brown Bag mentions to listeners that health experts are warning that people should not be getting pre cut fruit from the grocery. Experts also suggest washing pre-cut fruit and say that melons are the worst one. Health experts are saying that when they cut the fruit most times they are not washed correctly contaminating the pre cut fruit.
3. Community / Politics	Brown Bag Mornings	10/24	9:39am-9:52am	13mins	Brown Bag spoke with Mayor Karen Bass about the community. Started with the changes of helping the homeless problem California is experiencing. How they are making these changes as far as evictions etc. to prevent more people from being homeless. Also encouraged people to go out and vote. From speaking on her first time at the voting polls. To have people come together and support those who are trying to create change for the community, power in numbers. Brown Bag directs our listeners to the instagram page at vozvotovida.
4. Community	Brown Bag Mornings	11/7	8:14am-8:20am	6mins	Brown Bag warns the listeners to be careful with how to throw away painted pumpkins. Brown Bag directs the community to an event called "The Great Pumpkin Bash" located at the Grove on Sunday November 5th. The event is there to gather and help dispose of painted pumpkins the correct way.
5. Community / weather	Brown Bag Mornings	11/8	6:13am-6:17am	4mins	Brown Bag warns the listeners that do to heavy wind activity So. Cal. Edison may shut off the power in certain areas. This is an attempt to lower the risk of fires from starting and spreading due to heavy wind activity.
6. Community / Highway	Brown Bag Mornings	11/20	6:11am-6:17am	6mins	Brown Bag notifies listeners that the 10 freeway will now be open for use but will close at times in order to continue working on the freeway.
7. Community	Felli Fel	11/20	5:16pm-5:18pm	2mins	Felli Fel informs listeners of a thanksgiving event with Hands That Survive. They will be hosting a free turkey giveaway on Wednesday starting at 12pm located at 3010 Star ave in LA first come first serve requires RSVP

8. Community / Laws	Brown Bag Mornings	11/22	6:10am-6:14am	4mins	Brown Bag notifies that LA county is creating a way to help control gun violence. LA County is providing free gun locks for gun owners. To receive a gun lock you will have to go to a county hospital.
9. Community / Laws	Brown Bag Mornings	12/8	7:12am-7:17am	5mins	Brown Bag Mornings informs their listeners of A.I. cameras installed on LA Metro Buses to issue tickets to illegally parked cars in bus lanes. They discuss various things that can happen and how it affects the community.
10. Community / Recycling	Brown Bag Mornings	12/11	8:26am-8:30am	4mins	Brown Bag Mornings notifies the community of “Active Recycling” a recycling company that is giving out trees to people who recycle. The owners goal is to not have anyone do illegal recycling and help clean up the city.
11. Community / Recycling	Brown Bag Mornings	12/13	7:14am-7:19am	5mins	Brown Bag Mornings notifies the community that now bottles containing alcohol can now be recycled including milk cartons. They discuss the amount of what each will be when recycled.
12. Community / Politics	Brown Bag Mornings	12/15	8:14am-8:26am	12mins	Brown Bar Mornings is joined by Tony Cardenas to encourage the community to vote. They do this through “Tu Voz Tu Voto Tu Vida” encouraging to vote for not only the community but for your family. Their voice matters and can create change or laws to make things better.
